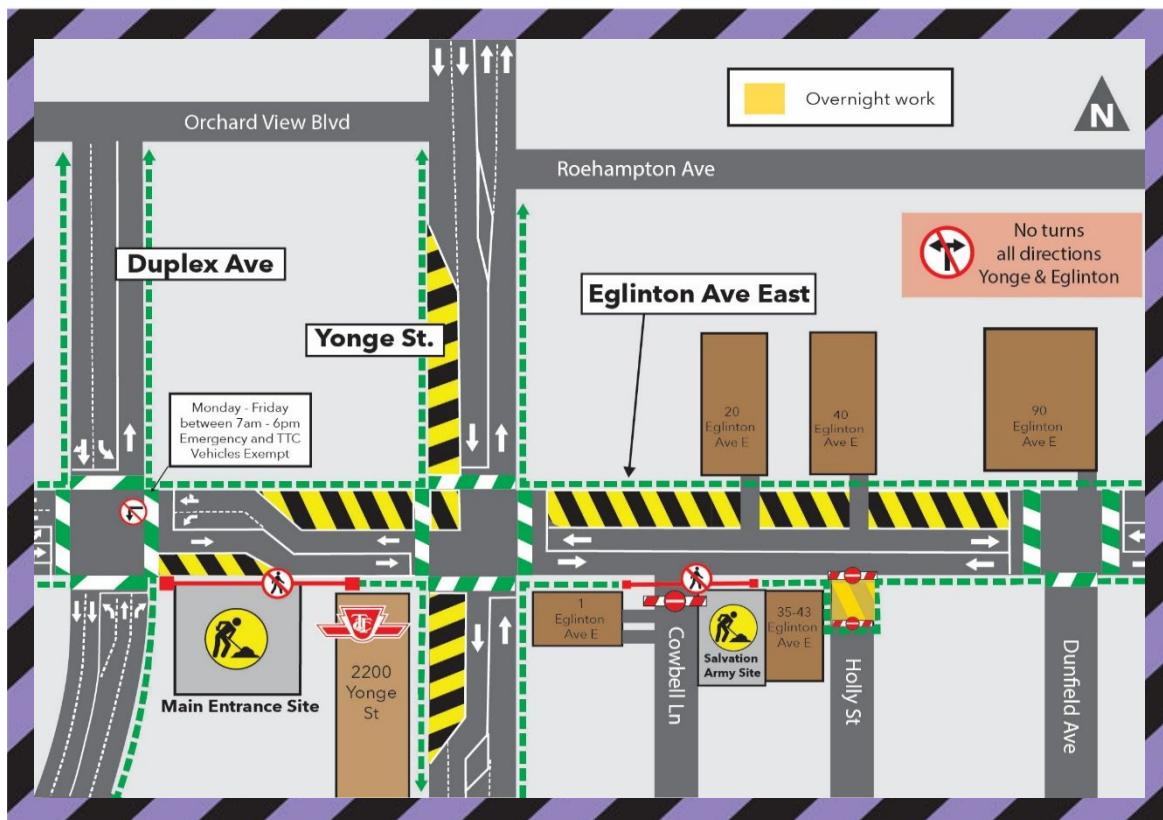


Extended: Overnight Work on Holly Street at Eglinton Avenue East for Utility Upgrades and Road Restoration

Until Sunday, January 21, 2024



What Work is Taking Place?

Through until approximately the morning of Sunday, January 21, 2024, crews will be performing overnight work on Holly Street at Eglinton Avenue East to facilitate utility upgrades and road restoration at Eglinton Station. Construction activities are expected to take place on a 24-hour

basis and will include excavation, wet and dry utility installations, backfilling, concrete works, and paving. Holly Street will remain closed at Eglinton Avenue East for the duration of work. All other traffic staging will remain in place. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Overnight noise from construction activity, including trucks, breaking of concrete and asphalt, utility work, and use of heavy equipment can be expected. No vehicular access between Eglinton Avenue East and Holly Street. Construction vehicles and trucks will stage within work zones and traffic tapers. Traffic barrels, fencing, signage, and other equipment will be erected to delineate work zones. Occasionally, the use of a hydro-vacuum truck, jack-hammer, and/or compaction roller will be required.

HOURS OF WORK

- Through until approximately the morning of Sunday, January 21, 2024.
- Work is expected to take place on Monday - Saturday on a 24-hour basis.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Holly Street will remain closed at Eglinton Avenue East.
- All other traffic staging will remain in place.
- Access to driveways will be maintained at all times.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrians will continue to be rerouted south around the work zone on Holly Street.
- Sidewalk widths on Holly Street may be reduced in certain areas to accommodate the works.
- All other pedestrian staging in the area will remain in place.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- Access to TTC will be maintained at all times.
