


Air Monitoring Installation at Pape Avenue

Expected start: January 27, 2024

Expected duration: Monitoring from January 2024 to June 2024

Timing: 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.



What's happening?

- Work is underway to deliver the long-awaited Ontario Line, a new 15.6-kilometre subway line that will run from the Ontario Science Centre all the way to Exhibition Place, with 15 stations along the way.
- A crew of 1-2 persons will be on-site to install an air monitor on city property adjacent to 425 Pape Ave., which will take approximately five hours to install. This is necessary as it provides an understanding of existing levels that will be compared to levels during construction.
- The monitoring program will measure ambient air quality levels during construction, to identify and mitigate against contaminants (if any) that may be disrupted due to construction activities.

What to expect

- Crew will be using hand-held devices including tripod, data logger, microphone, and air monitor to carry out this work.
- There will be no impacts to sidewalks, driveways, or residential properties for this work.
- Set up of the monitoring equipment will take approximately four (4) hours, and removal will take approximately four (4) hours. The date to remove the air monitor is not known and will be communicated once confirmed.
- After setup, site visits will be conducted on weekdays during daytime hours, approximately 2 - 3 times a week to check the monitors, deploy/retrieve samples, and perform maintenance on the monitors, as required.
- This work is non-intrusive and is not expected to have any impact to the residents and motorists who use the parking lot.
- All necessary permits have been obtained.
- After the monitoring period is complete, all equipment associated with the baseline monitoring program will be removed from the site.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
