# Continuous Weekend Construction at Hurontario Street and Hillcrest Avenue/Kirwin Avenue

Friday February 2, 2024, at 7 p.m., to Monday February 5, 2024, at 5 a.m.

• Access to Kirwin Avenue will be maintained from Hurontario Street Friday February 9, 2024, at 7 p.m., to Monday February 12, 2024, at 5 a.m.

• Access to Hillcrest Avenue will be maintained from Hurontario Street



# What work is taking place?

As utility upgrades progress in the area, crews will be installing sanitary infrastructure on Hurontario Street near Hillcrest Avenue/Kirwin Avenue continuously over the course of two weekends: Friday February 2, 2024, to Monday February 5, 2024, and Friday February 9, 2024, to Monday February 12, 2024. The work for both weekends will begin on Friday at 7 p.m. and continue to Monday at 5 a.m. Continuous weekend work is required so crews can minimize the impact on traffic, safely relocate sewer mains, and install pipes and manholes to the west side of Hurontario.

For phase one, through traffic will be restricted from Hillcrest Avenue eastbound to Hurontario and Kirwin Avenue.

For phase two, through traffic will be restricted from Kirwin Avenue westbound to Hurontario and Hillcrest Avenue.

Left turns will be restricted during each phase. Please follow detours and other traffic signs. Transit services will be impacted by these works. In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

- Work is scheduled at Hillcrest Avenue/Kirwin Avenue and Hurontario Street over two weekends:
  - Friday February 2, 2024, to Monday February 5, 2024
  - Friday February 9, 2024, to Monday February 12, 2024
- The work will be continuous throughout this duration on both weekends from Friday at 7 p.m. and continue to Monday at 5 a.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

#### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Emergency access will not be maintained to/from the side street closures to Hurontario Street.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators,

loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
