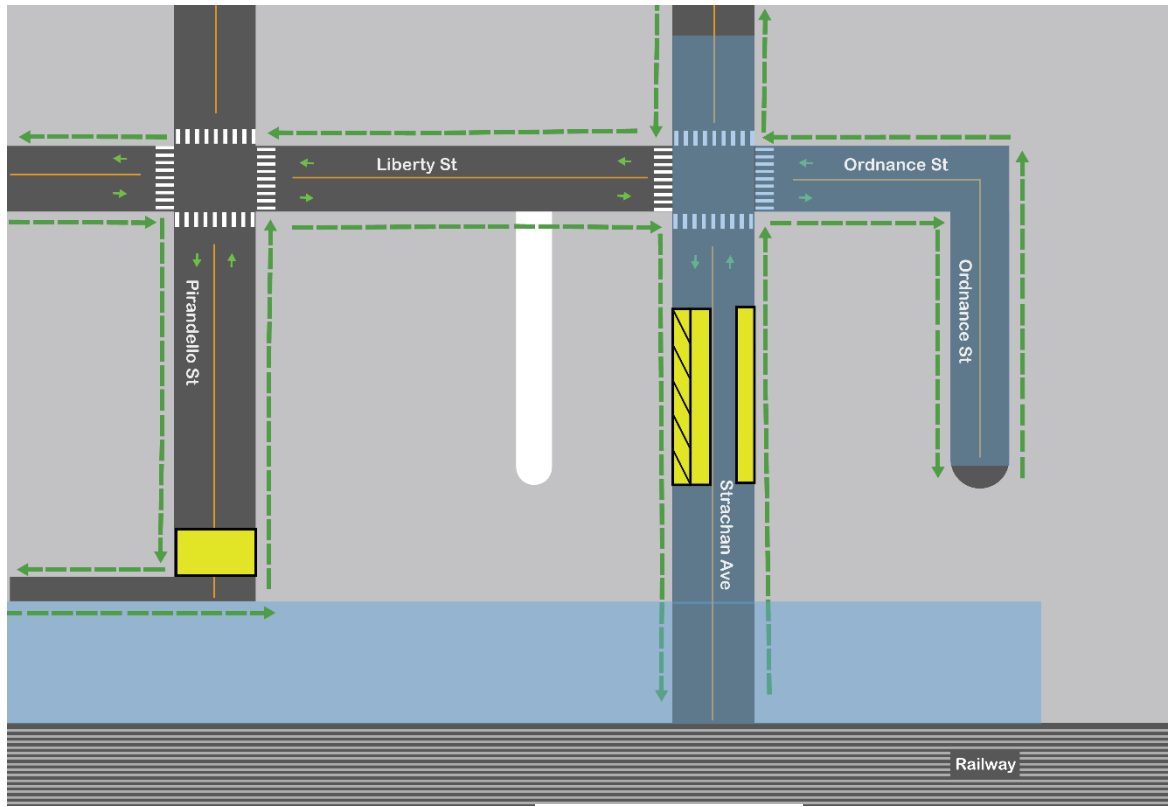


UPDATED: Overnight sewer and utility surveying near Exhibition Station

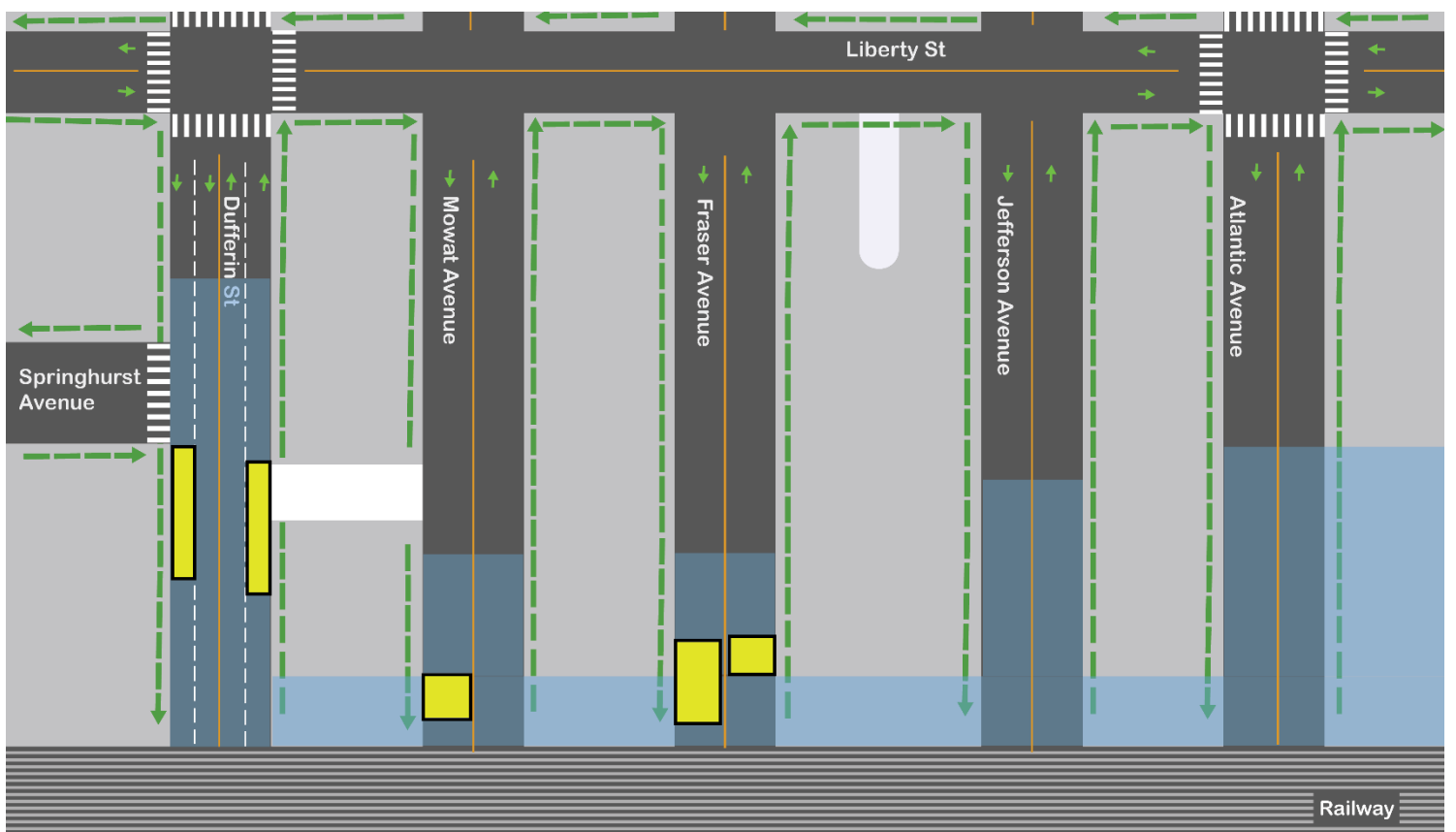
Expected Start Date: As early as February 5, 2024

Expected End Date: Up to April 30, 2024

Planned work hours: Overnight 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., daytime from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

What is happening?

- Construction crews will continue to survey utilities and conduct sewer inspections for a select number of days per month, in the areas shown in yellow on the map above. This work will now take place day and night, with work crews on site between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., as well as 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Crews will move around within the locations shown on the map as each site will take one or two nights to complete the work.
- Temporary lane closures are required for crews to safely carry out the survey work.
- The work is done by accessing sewer manholes to assess internal conditions of sewers and cabling before station construction begins.
- Crews will drill into the road to inspect utilities under the roadway. Once complete, the drill areas will be restored.
- Equipment such as a saw cutter and a hydrovac truck will be used.

What to expect

- There will be various closures north and southbound on Dufferin Street, Mowat Avenue, Fraser Avenue, Pirandello Street, and Strachan Avenue.
- The southbound bike lane on Strachan Avenue will merge with the traffic lane.
- A traffic control person will be at each closure guiding traffic.
- Residents will hear noise from work equipment.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
