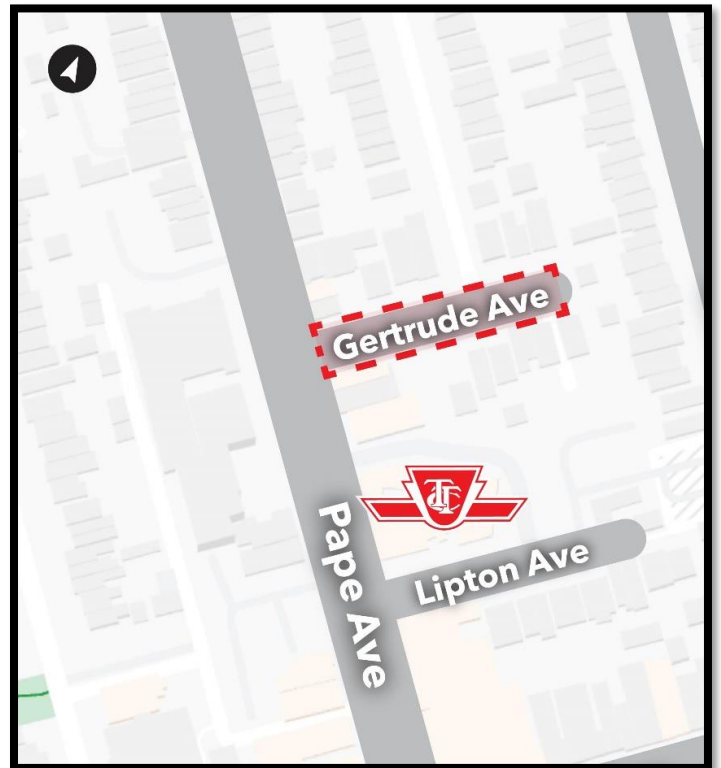


Ground level monitoring overnight near Pape & Sammon and Pape & Gertrude

Expected start date: Four nights beginning as early as February 5, 2024

Expected completion date: February 9, 2024

Timing: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.



Areas within the dotted red lines show where crews will collect ground level data.

What is happening?

- Beginning as early as February 5, crews will be performing ground level monitoring overnight in the vicinity of Pape Avenue and Sammon Avenue, as well as near Pape Avenue and Gertrude Avenue.
- Monitoring will be performed on sidewalks, laneways, and the roadway within the area outlined on the map above.
- Crews will be measuring ground elevation to obtain baseline data in advance of tunnelling work which will happen in the future.
- All necessary permits have been obtained.

What to expect

- Crews will use a digital level to measure elevation at approximately 30 points along the areas outlined above.
- Work will take place between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. to reduce the impacts on pedestrians and vehicles in the area.
- Short-term lane closures will be required for points located within the roadway. A paid-duty officer and traffic management staff will be on-site to direct traffic as required.

- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
