

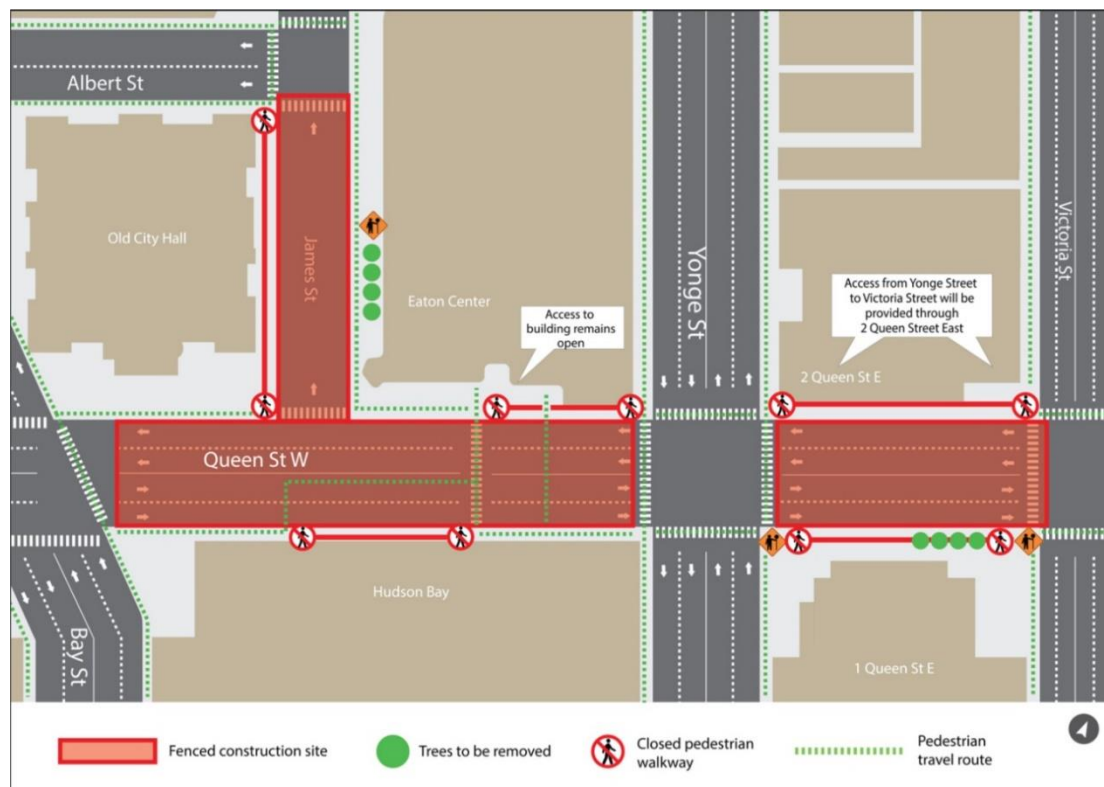
Tree removal on James Street and Queen Street East

Expected Start Date: February 8, 2024

Expected Duration: One night.

Planned work hours: Overnight, from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

What is happening?

- In preparation for construction activities at the future new Ontario Line Queen Station, crews will be removing four (4) trees on James Street and four (4) trees on Queen Street East.
- This work is expected to take one day and will be performed overnight, between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

What to expect

- Tree removals will take place along the east side of James Street and the south side of Queen Street East between Yonge Street and Victoria Street, as per the map above.
- The sidewalk in front 1 Queen Street East will be temporarily closed during the hours of work. Access to the building will be maintained.
- The sidewalk in front of 2 Queen Street East will remain closed, as it is currently to support construction activities. The 2 Queen Street East building remains accessible, and pedestrians can access Yonge Street and Victoria Street via the building lobby during operating hours.
- Flag-persons will be stationed at each side of the work zone, including the intersection of Queen Street East and Victoria Street to guide pedestrians and ensure safety distance during the tree removal process.
- The work zone on James Street will be supervised by flag-persons stationed on the sidewalk, in front of the Eaton Centre.

- The sidewalk along James Street will remain open to pedestrians and the work zone will be properly secured. All entrances and exits along James Street will be maintained.
- Nearby residents will hear noise from work equipment like tree cutters or chain saws.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
