
Lakeshore West Rail Corridor Maintenance - Bridge Rehab

Parkside Drive, Colborne Lodge Drive, Ellis Avenue, Windermere Avenue and South Kigsway Drive - February 12, 2024 - June 7, 2024



What You Need to Know

Starting February 12, 2024, Metrolinx will be continuing bridge maintenance along the Lakeshore West (LSW) rail corridor. We will be continuing to rehabilitate the Parkside Drive Bridge, Colborne Lodge Dr Bridge, Ellis Ave Bridge Bridge, Windermere Ave Bridge and the South Kingsway Bridge between the Queensway & Lakeshore Blvd W. This construction notice is for the remaining work at all five (5) bridge locations.

Work includes installation of new permanent handrails on the bridge at all five (5) bridges during the night time between 9:00pm and 5:00am starting **February 12 until March 1, 2024**. During this same period, daytime work may occur for other maintenance and rehabilitation activities such as steel repairs and electrical works.

Work at Windermere Avenue is scheduled between **April 15 - June 7** during daytime hours. We have worked with the City to develop the required lane closures where the work will occur. Some overnight work will occur,

however we will make the necessary effots to reduce community impacts. We understand that we are conducting rail maintenance in some residential area's along the rail corridor, and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and we will complete this work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you. The timeframe of work is subject to change based on work progress.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Anticipated overnight work for bridge rehab and maintenance.
- Overnight work is necessary so trains can run throughout the day.
- You can expect short term and long term lane closures.
- Noise levels may be elevated in the areas surrounding the work locations.
- You may see lights so workers can opeprate safely at night. Our teams always work hard to minimize community impacts.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will take place overnight on weekdays from 9:00pm to 5:00am between February 12 and March 1, 2024. Short term lane closures will be in place.
- Daytime work is also possible between February 12 and March 1, 2024 for other structural rehabilitation works including steel repairs and electrical work. Short term lane closures will be in place.
- Daytime work at Windermere is scheduled between April 15 and June 7. Long term lane closures will be in place.
- Maintenance work is being completed during the night time to avoid disruption to the Lakeshore West GO Trains
- Productivity each night varies depending on a variety of factors such as weather.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are anticipated lane closures on all five (5) roads where work is taking place.
- Work will only take place at one (1) bridge at a time.
- Traffic will be reduced to single lane traffic where work is occurring.
- Please review traffic signs and drive with care in areas of work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

• There are no anticipated pedestrian impacts.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- There are no anticipated transit impacts. Trains will operate as scheduled throughout the day. Train schedules may vary based on service changes.
- Work will be completed within the LSW Rail Corridor.
