Maple GO: North Platform Closure for Stair Structure Construction

March 11, 2024 to Spring 2025



What is happening?

In order to complete the tunnel connections to the new west platform at Maple GO, Metrolinx will be constructing an access structure on the north half of the existing east platform. This access structure consists of stairs and an elevator that will allow riders to easily move between the east and west platforms once complete. Similar work was recently completed at the south end of the platform, and the south platform will become the active boarding/unboarding area early in 2024.

What does this mean for residents?

Residents located along the northern half of Lindenshire Ave may experience more noise, vibration, and dust than usual. However, we will be monitoring constantly to ensure that noise and vibration levels are within the appropriate limits (determined by industry standards). Crews will minimize impacts where possible. We thank you for your patience while this important work is being completed.

What does this mean for customers?

Between March 2024 and Spring 2025, customers at Maple GO will have to board from the south end of the platform, as the north platform will be closed. Train doors aligning with the north platform will not open. Boarding and unboarding will take place from the accessibility coach and all cars to the south.
