


# Temporary Road Closure of Harbourn Road at Hurontario Street

Friday, February 23, 2024 and Saturday February 24, 2024

8:30 p.m to 5:30 a.m. each night



## What work is taking place?

Construction crews will be installing new stormwater connections along Hurontario Street, resulting in a temporary road closure of a portion of Harborn Road. This closure is scheduled to take place on the nights of Friday, February 23, 2024 and Saturday February 24, 2024, from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. each night. These works are being scheduled during the night so that they can be completed safely and efficiently. Emergency access will not be maintained during the closure.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. ## TIMING

- A portion of Harborn Road will be closed from the nights of February 23-24, 2024.
- The closure hours are **8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. each night.**
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

## TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Access to Harborn Road will be maintained through a detour from Hurontario Street, The Queensway, Stavebank Road and Premium Way.
- Emergency access will not be maintained during the closure.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

## WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

## TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay near the intersection will continue to operate with regular service.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stop as boarding areas may be located.

## PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
