Update: Overnight weekend utility work near the Don Yard

Expected dates and hours of work:

Utility relocations will take place Friday to Sunday between 8 p.m. - 5 a.m. on the following weekends:

- March 1 3, 2024
- March 8 10, 2024
- March 15 17, 2024 (contingency)



What is happening?

- Utility relocation work began in January 2024 within the work areas shown on the map above.
- This work will continue through Spring 2024 and take place during three specific weekends in March 2024 exact dates listed below:
 - March 1 3, 2024
 - o March 8 10, 2024
 - March 15 17, 2024 (contingency weekend)

METROLINX

- Overnight weekend work is required to complete construction activities that workers cannot do safely while trains are active in the rail corridor.
- These utilities need to be relocated to make space for new diversion tracks and prepare for construction of the future cut and cover portal.
- A directional drill, excavator, and hydro-vacuum truck will be used to complete this work.
- No traffic or pedestrian closures are expected.

What to expect

- Noise from construction equipment including a directional drill, excavator, and hydrovacuum truck.
- A hydro-vacuum truck will be required to safely carry out some work due to the limited space between the construction area and the existing buried utilities.
- Crews must use hydro-vac equipment when working within two meters of buried utilities to ensure public and worker safety and protect the utilities from damage.
- Trucks will enter and exit the site via Bayview Avenue or Mill Street.
- Noise mitigation measures will be implemented as required during the day and overnight.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
