
Tree Removals on University Avenue Median

Expected start date: Saturday, March 2, 2024 **Expected duration:** One (1) day **Hours of work:** 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- In preparation for construction activities at the future Osgoode Station, crews will be removing five trees in the University Avenue median, between Queen Street West and Armory Street.
- The work will occur in one shift, expected Saturday, March 2, 2024, between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Information as of: February 27, 2024

What to expect

- Community members can expect to see construction crews, trucks, and machinery such as a tree cutter and saw.
- Those nearby can expect to hear noise related to the work and can expect to see pylons and cones surrounding the trucks parked in designated areas to support the work, as required.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zone.
- Short-term traffic interruptions can be expected while trucks and equipment enter and exit work zones; traffic control personnel will be present to direct vehicles and pedestrians.
- Work may be delayed, rescheduled or the time frame extended due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
