




TRAFFIC CONFIGURATION AT LAIRD STATION

Expected through 2023




- Periodic short-term lane closures will be required during this traffic stage to facilitate specific activities

- Architectural and electrical deficiency works Numerous At-Grade Stops Ongoing through February 2024.








EAST PORTAL LANDSCAPING PLAN

- Completed tree planting including a mix of Common Hackberry, Swamp White Oak, English Oak, Tulip Tree, and Ohio Buckeye.
- Ongoing backfilling.
- Remaining planting includes Bluegrass, Native Prairie Meadow, and Woodlot seed mixtures.
