





TRAFFIC CONFIGURATION AT LAIRD STATION



- Fencing will remain in place around the Station Entrances for security purposes








EAST OF LAIRD ONGOING WORKS

- Architectural and electrical finished Numerous At-Grade Stops Ongoing through fall 2023




