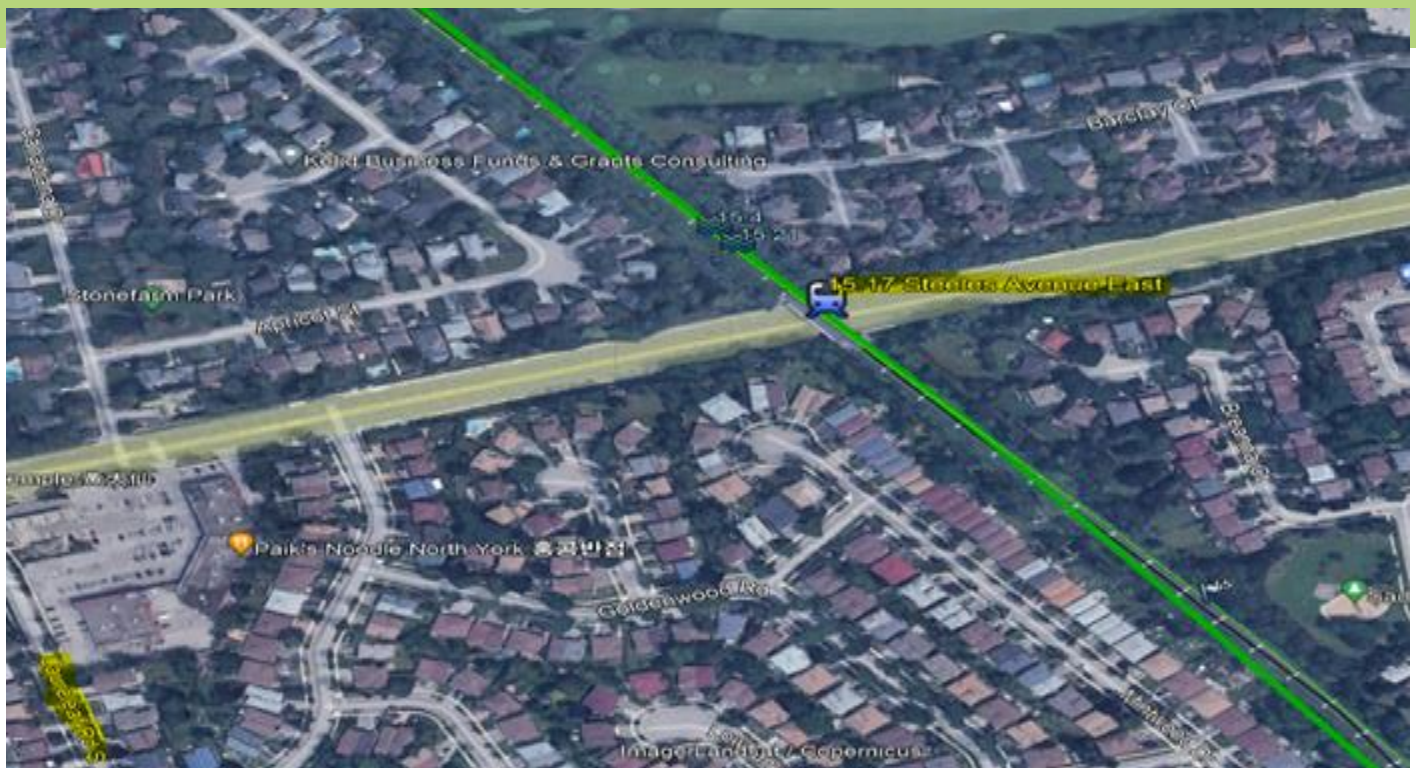


Steeles Avenue East Bridge Repairs (West of Leslie Street)

Mid-March to late April 2024 (timeline subject to change)



What is happening?

As a part of bridges and structures maintenance delivery, crews will be performing a concrete repair on a section of the pedestrian walkway on the Richmond Hill corridor bridge over Steeles Avenue. The sidewalks on the eastbound and westbound below the railway bridge will be closed to pedestrian traffic throughout the construction period to accommodate the bridge repair. Signage will be in place to assist pedestrian traffic.

What to expect

From March 11 to April 15, 2024, Metrolinx contractors will replace a section of concrete walkway slab in the walkway of the southwest corner of the railway bridge. **Construction crews will be on site Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

To accommodate this work and to keep the area safe the portion of the pedestrian walkway under the rail bridge will be closed. On the east side of the bridge, pedestrians will be redirected to cross at the intersection of Bluffwood Drive and Steeles Avenue, providing access to the west sidewalk. On the west side of the bridge, pedestrians will be redirected westbound to the traffic intersection at Laureleaf Road and Steeles Avenue before continuing eastbound. Wayfinding signage will be in place.
