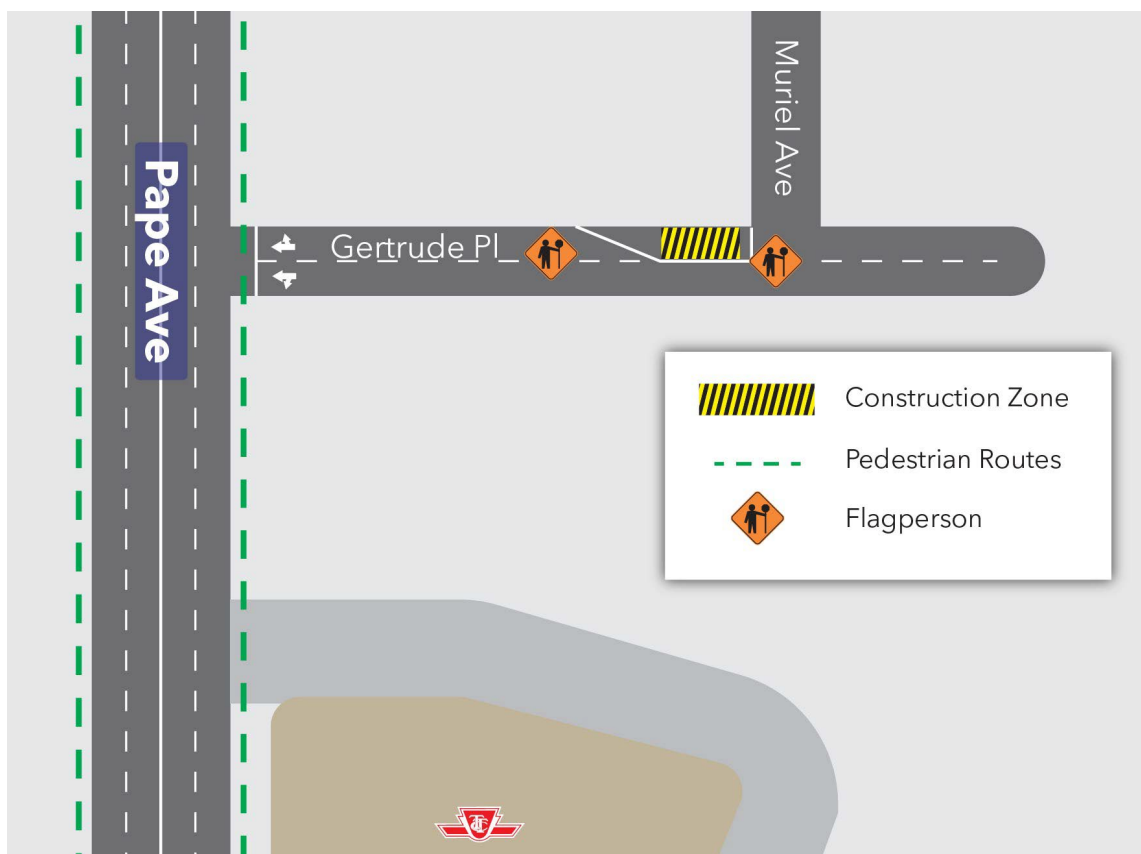


Utility investigations on Gertrude Place

Expected start date: As early as March 11, 2024

Expected completion date: Late March 2024

Hours of work: Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- To accommodate future excavation and construction of Pape Station on the Ontario Line, Metrolinx contractors will be excavating to reveal the sewer line on Gertrude Place.
- Through excavation, crews will determine the exact location of the sewer and reduce the risk of unintentional service impacts during major construction in the future.

What to expect

- Utility investigation work will begin as early as March 11, 2024 and take approximately three (3) weeks to complete.
- Work will involve the use of a hydro-excavator truck.
- Residents and businesses in the area may hear noise caused by work equipment. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Crews will occupy the northern half of Gertrude Place adjacent to the Gertrude Place and Muriel Avenue intersection. Flagpersons will be on site to coordinate vehicle traffic as required.
- There will be no sidewalk impacts from this work.

Note:

- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line
