


Bus Bay Construction and Bus Canopy Demolition at Pape Station

Expected start date: As early as March 25, 2024

Expected duration: Ten (10) weeks.

Hours of work: Monday - Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- To facilitate major construction at Pape Station for the Ontario Line, crews are beginning preparatory works that will involve closing bus bays 3 and 4 on the east side of the station and constructing replacement bus bays on Lipton Avenue.
- As early as March 25, 2024, crews will begin installing two new bus bays on the north side of Lipton Avenue. This work will take approximately one week.

- As early as April 1, crews will begin demolishing the bus loop canopy in the eastern portion of Pape Station where bays for TTC routes 72 and 81. This work will take approximately 10 weeks.
- Work will take place from Monday to Saturday between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

What to Expect

- TTC route 72 Pape will continue to serve the bus terminal from Bay 2.
- TTC routes 25 Don Mills and 925 Don Mills Express will now serve the station from the two new temporary bus bays off Lipton Avenue.
- TTC route 81 Thorncliffe will serve the station on-street, at a stop location just in front of the main entrance.
- Floor-to-ceiling hoarding will be installed to separate the accessible area of Pape Station from the work area.
- TTC customers and nearby residents can expect noise from construction work within the work zone shown above.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Signage will be in place to direct customers to the replacement bus bays.
- This work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary permits have been obtained.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
