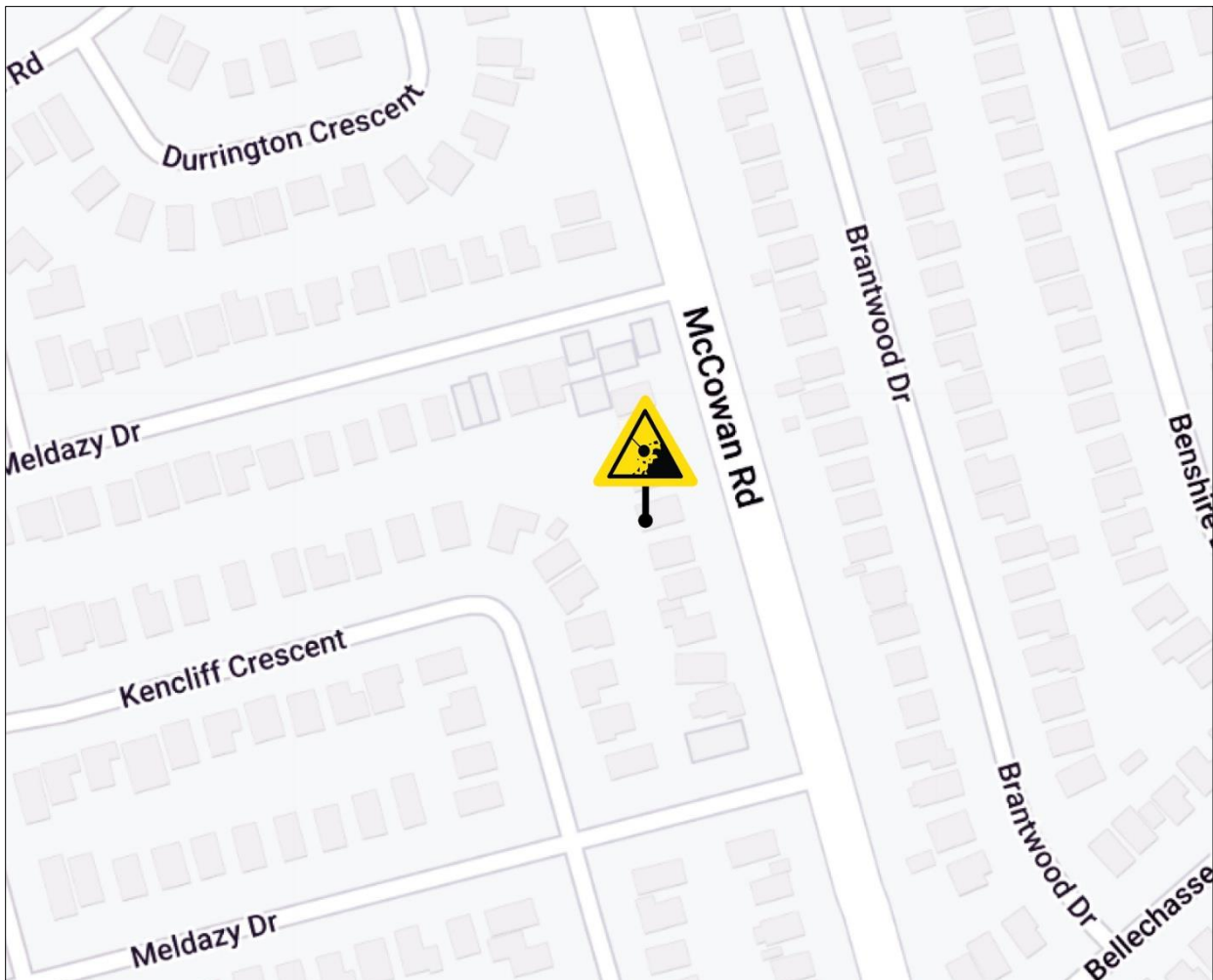


Building demolition at 960 McCowan Road

Scheduled start: January 23, 2024

Timing: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m

What is happening?

- To prepare for construction of a new emergency exit for the Scarborough Subway Extension a residential building needs to be demolished at 960 McCowan Road.
- The residential building located at 960 McCowan Road will be demolished during the first quarter of 2024, approximately.
- All necessary permits will be acquired before any work begins.

What to expect

- Once underway, demolition activity will take approximately two months to complete.
- Work areas will be clearly marked and fenced off with hoarding to ensure public safety. Where needed and possible, fencing will feature a slit cloth to help control dust and debris.
- Flaggers will be used to ensure trucks entering and exiting the property do so safely.
- Some equipment may be left on site for the duration of work but will be safely secured and stored when not in use.
- Residents near the site may hear noise caused by the demolition activity. We will monitor noise and vibration levels during these activities and will take steps to mitigate when necessary.
- We do not anticipate the need for any sidewalk closures, pedestrian detours or traffic flow restrictions while this work is underway.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- The Scarborough Subway Extension will bring the TTC's Line 2 subway service nearly eight kilometres farther into Scarborough, helping to reduce travel times and improve access to jobs, schools and other key destinations throughout the city.
- It will extend from Kennedy Station to Sheppard Avenue and McCowan Road, with three new stops at Lawrence and McCowan, Scarborough Town Centre and Sheppard and McCowan.
