
Geotechnical Work at 960 McCowan Road

Scheduled start: Approximately February 20, 2024 - April 20, 2024

Timing: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

What is Happening?

• To make room for an emergency exit along the Scarborough Subway Extension, there will be geotechnical investigative work at 960 McCowan Road. The purpose of this work is to collect important soil and water information to build the emergency exit infrastructure.

Timeline

 Geotechincal work at 960 McCowan Road will take place beginning approximately February 20th for a two month duration.

What to Expect

- Geotechnical work requires the drilling of boreholes and testing soil conditions which is required before the future construction of the emergency exit infrastructure.
- Residents can expect to see a small drill rig, trucks, and a crew working on the property on a periodic basis.
- Some equipment may be left on site for the duration of work but will be safely secured and stored when not in use.
- Residents near the site may hear noise caused during this activity. We are monitoring noise and vibration levels during these activities and will take steps to mitigate when necessary.
- We do not anticipate the need for any sidewalk closures, pedestrian detours or traffic flow restrictions while this work is underway.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Project

- The Scarborough Subway Extension will bring the TTC's Line 2 subway service nearly eight kilometres farther into Scarborough, helping to reduce travel times and improve access to jobs, schools and other key destinations throughout the city.
- It will extend from Kennedy Station to Sheppard Avenue and McCowan Road, with three new stops at Lawrence and McCowan, Scarborough Town Centre and Sheppard and McCowan.
- The project is expected to boost ridership by 105,000 people per day and give 38,000 people walkable access to transit.
