



Don Valley Parkway Traffic Lane Closures

Expected start date: As early as Monday, April 1, 2024

Expected duration: One month

Hours of work: Monday - Sunday overnight between 11 p.m. - 5 a.m.





What is happening?

- Starting Monday, April 1, 2024, traffic lanes on the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) will be closed nightly to install new utilities on the DVP rail bridge.
- These new utilities are required to facilitate construction of the new Ontario Line subway.
- To mitigate traffic impacts, lane closures will take place overnight on weekdays and periodically on weekends between 11 p.m. – 5 a.m.
- The on-ramp and off-ramp connecting the DVP to Don Roadway and Lakeshore Blvd. E. will be closed periodically during some stages of work.
- **Multiple traffic stages will be implemented to facilitate this work; each stage will take approximately five nights to complete. Please refer to the maps above or read the full notice below for specific traffic details.**

Traffic details

- **Stage one:**
 - The DVP south will be reduced to one lane from north of Eastern Ave. to the exit ramp onto the Gardiner Expressway.

- **Stage two:**
 - The DVP south will be reduced to one lane from north of Eastern Ave. to the exit ramp onto the Gardiner Expressway.
 - The exit ramp from DVP South to Don Roadway/Lake Shore Blvd. E. will be closed.
- **Stage three:**
 - The DVP South and North will be reduced to one lane at the on and off ramps to the Gardiner Expressway.
 - The exit ramp from DVP South to Don Roadway/Lake Shore Blvd. E. will be closed.
- **Stage four:**
 - The DVP North will be reduced to one lane from the exit ramp onto the Gardiner Expressway south of Eastern Ave.
 - The on ramp from Don Roadway/Lake Shore Blvd. E. to DVP North will be closed.

What to expect

- Noise from construction machinery including a hydro-vacuum truck and track equipment can be expected.
- Closures of ramps connecting the DVP and Don Roadway/Lake Shore Blvd. E.
- Overnight lane reductions on DVP North and South can be expected.
- Road closures just north of the Don Roadway and Lake Shore Blvd. E. intersection can be expected.
- No pedestrian impacts are expected as a result of this work.
- Periodic use of a hydro-vacuum truck will be required to safely carry out this work due to the limited space between the construction works and the existing buried utilities.
- Crews must use non-mechanical excavation methods (hydro-vacuuming) when working within 2 meters of buried utilities to ensure public and worker safety and protect the utilities from damage.
- Traffic, road closure, and construction warning signage will in place in advance of the lane closures to notify drivers.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
