
Extended: Fence Construction at the Traction Power Substation at 1800 Eglinton Avenue East

Through Spring 2024



What Work is Taking Place?

Through Spring 2024, crews will continue to construct a new metal fence around the Traction Power Substation (TPSS) at 1800 Eglinton Avenue East.

To facilitate this work, short term lane reductions may be required on Eglinton Avenue East, in front of 1800 Eglinton Avenue East.

One lane of traffic in each direction will be always maintained. Property access to 1530 Victoria Park Avenue will be always maintained. Construction activities include concrete removals, digging, hammering, and drilling, and concrete pours.

This work is expected to take place on Monday - Friday, between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Construction of a new 3 to 4-metre-tall metal fence. Noise from construction activities can be expected.

HOURS OF WORK

- Ongoing through Spring 2024.
- This work is expected to take place Monday Friday between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- This work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- This work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Periodic lane closures may be required on Eglinton Avenue East, in front of 1800 Eglinton Avenue East.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be always maintained.
- Property access to 1530 Victoria Park Avenue will be always maintained.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

Temporary pedestrian rerouting may be required during this work.
