
Extended: Fence Construction at the Traction Power Substation at 795 Warden Avenue

Through Spring 2024



What Work is Taking Place?

Through Spring 2024, crews will continue constructing a new metal fence around the Traction Power Substation at 795 Warden Avenue. To facilitate this work, access to the laneway on the south side of 1923 Eglinton Avenue East will be periodically restricted and access to the southwest corner of the parking lot at 1941 Eglinton Avenue East will be restricted.

Construction activities include concrete removals, digging, hammering, and drilling, and concrete pours. This work is expected to take place on Monday - Friday, between 7:00 a.m.

and 5:00 p.m. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Construction of a new 3 to 4-metre-tall metal fence. Temporary barriers will be installed during the time of the fence construction. Noise from construction activities can be expected. Affected properties have been notified directly.

HOURS OF WORK

- Ongoing through Spring 2024.
- This work is expected to take place Monday Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- This work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- This work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Access to the laneway on the south side of 1923 Eglinton Avenue East will be periodically restricted.
- Access to the southwest corner of the parking lot at 1941 Eglinton Avenue East will be restricted.
