

Tree removals on Eglinton Avenue West between Scarlett Road and Jane Street

Expected Start Date: Week of March 25, 2024

Work hours: Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- Crews will remove 127 trees as part of the early works for the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension's elevated guideway.
- All removal and pruning of trees and vegetation in this area has been approved by the City of Toronto.
- Bird nesting survey to be undertaken before tree removals take place.
- Metrolinx will plant more trees than we remove as we build more sustainable transit for the community.
- Metrolinx is working closely with the City of Toronto and the Toronto Region Conservation Authority to plant new trees as early as possible. Learn more about our tree planting program at [metrolinx.com/vegetation](https://www.metrolinx.com/vegetation).

What to expect

- Sidewalks and crosswalks may be closed periodically during this work.
- Short-term lane closures may be required to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.
- There will be flaggers and traffic signs to direct traffic, as needed.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometers from the Mount Dennis station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground.
- The route will cross the Humber River floodplain zone. Elevating the line through the area on a climate-resilient elevated guideway is the best way to provide safe, reliable service for commuters.
- Once complete, the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
