
Long Branch GO: Temporary Pathway

What You Need to Know

Starting end of March 2024, crews will be working on the Temporary Multi-use Pathway located on the north side of the rail corridor at Long Branch GO Station. The construction of the temporary path will include:

- The necessary clearing and cutting of trees and vegetation.
- Minor excavation.
- Placement of aggregate and modular interlocking pathway.

Project Overview

Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15- minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service. This includes accessibility and amenity improvements to Toronto's Long Branch GO Station.

Work	Scheduled Start Date	Expected Duration	Work Hours	Description of Work
Shrub and Tree Removals	End of March	Approx. 1-2 weeks	Day Shift	Crews will be clearing shrubs and trees to create the temporary pathway.
Construction of Temporary Path	Beginning of April	Approx. 4 weeks	Day Shift	Crews will be placing temp lighting and hard plastic interlocking tiles along the temporary pathway
East Platform Demolition	Beginning of May	Approx. 1 year	Day & Overnight Shift	Crews will be closing the staircase from Edgeware Drive and east side of the platforms to start work on the east tunnel, platform rehabilitation, and east station building.

* Please note that work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances

What to Expect

- Residents should expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting.
- Our operations staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters.

Hours of Work

• Day work is expected to take place Monday to Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Mitigation Measures

- Lights will be pointed away from residential windows.
- Work area will be safely delineated.
- Construction noise and vibration will be monitored.
- Street sweeper and cleaning as required.

Traffic Details

- Increased construction vehicles and equipment can be expected in the work area.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.

Pedestrian Details

- North staircase access on Edgeware Drive will be closed as of Early May.
- Pedestrian access to the station from the north will be via a temporary access route which will connect you to the north platform and tunnel at the west end of the station.
