

Construction hoarding installation near Exhibition Station

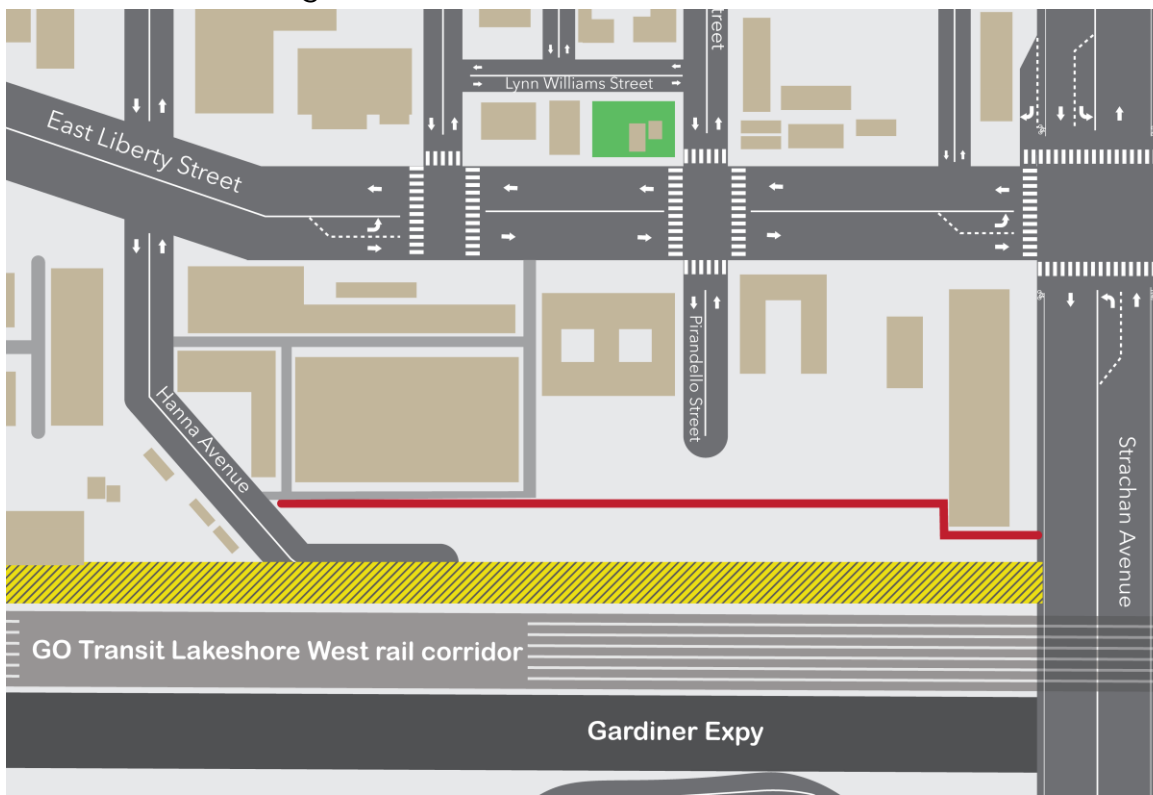
Expected start date: As early as April 16, 2024

Expected duration: Up to 2 months

Hours of work: Daily from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

What is happening?

As part of ongoing construction of the Ontario Line and Exhibition Station, crews will be installing long-term hoarding at the future Ontario Line subway portal site, commencing near Pirandello Avenue, and moving westward toward Hanna Avenue.



This work will take place as early as April 16, 2024.

Once complete, the hoarding will be painted and branded, to ensure a clean and aesthetically appealing construction site, as Metrolinx strives to be a good neighbour.

This work is done entirely within the Exhibition construction sites, and will not impact traffic, vehicles, or pedestrian traffic foot traffic.

Area residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from work equipment, specifically the assembly of plywood panels and materials being unloaded from trucks.

Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.

What to expect

- Starting in the afternoon of April 16, crews will be working to install long-term fencing east of Exhibition Station, on the north side of the rail corridor as an enhanced site safety measure.
- There will be no lane or pedestrian barriers as the long-term hoarding is installed. Equipment such as trucks, cargo vans will be in place to a loading truck.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
