#### **OVERVIEW:**

On Tuesday, April 2, 2024, Metrolinx hosted a virtual Queen/Spadina CLC session meeting in partnership with OTG. Metrolinx and Ontario Transit Group (OTG) provided a construction update accompanied with awareness/safety tips about spring flooding.
