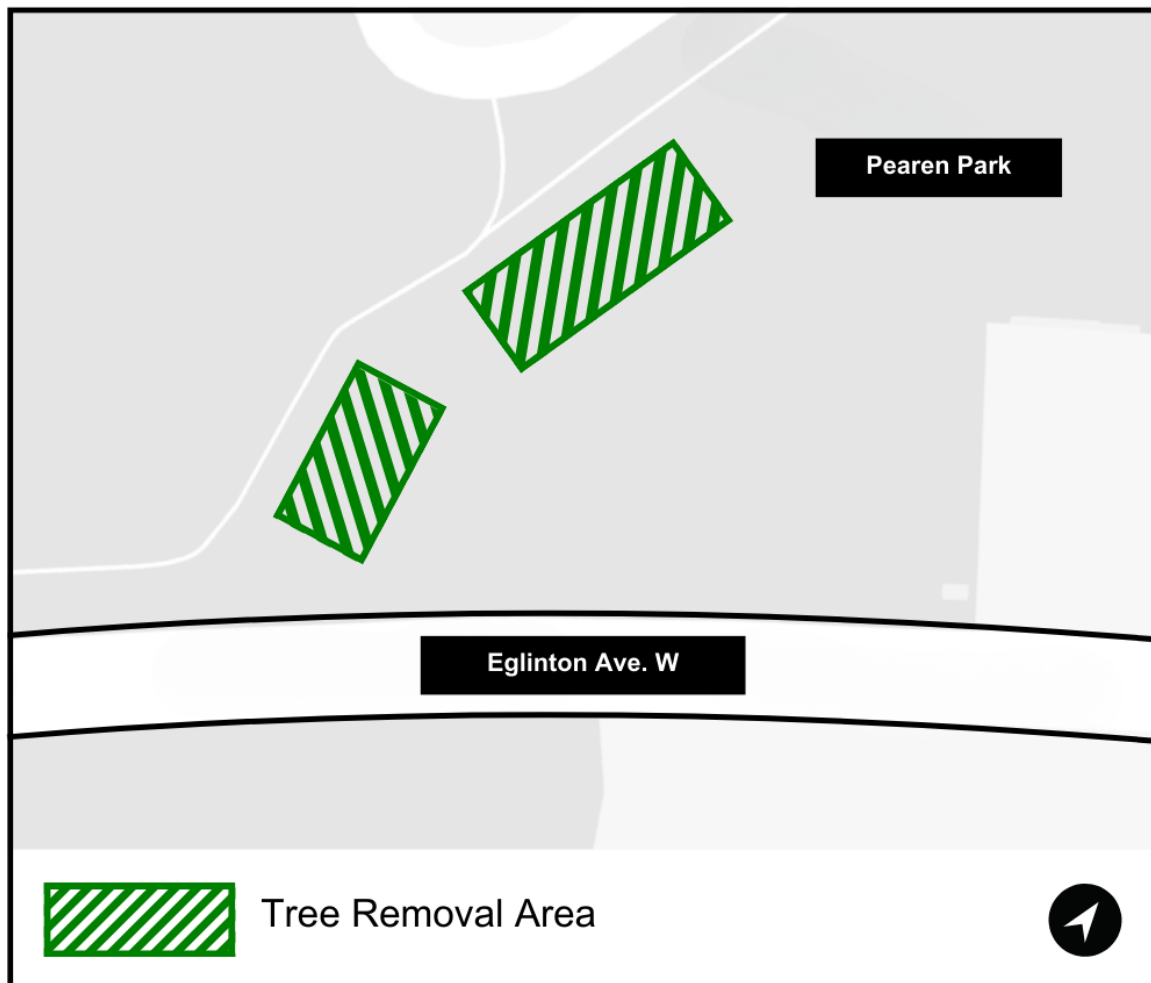


# Tree Removals and Pruning in Pearen Park

**Scheduled start:** As early as the week of April 15, 2024

**Timing:** Weekdays, 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

## What is happening?

Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be removing five trees and pruning three additional trees on the north side of Pearen Park.

- These removals are needed to accommodate tunneling work for the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension.
- All removal and pruning of trees and vegetation in this area has been approved by the City of Toronto. Bird nesting survey to be undertaken before tree removals take place.
- Metrolinx will plant more trees than we remove as we build more sustainable transit for the community.
- Metrolinx is working closely with the City of Toronto and the Toronto Region Conservation Authority to plant new trees as early as possible. Learn more about our tree planting program at [metrolinx.com/vegetation](https://metrolinx.com/vegetation).

## Hours of work

- Work will take place starting the week of April 15, 2024, from Monday - Friday, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- Work may be delayed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

## What to expect

- Work areas will be fenced off and secured as needed to ensure public safety. They will also be clearly marked with signage. Crews will install barriers around nearby trees that are being protected and preserved.
- Minor sidewalk and road impacts can be expected.
- Any equipment will be safely secured and stored while not in use.
- Residents and businesses near work sites may hear noise caused by chainsaws and woodchippers.
- Work is expected to take place over several weeks and may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
- Weekend work may be required on occasion.

## About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometers from the future Mount Dennis LRT station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
