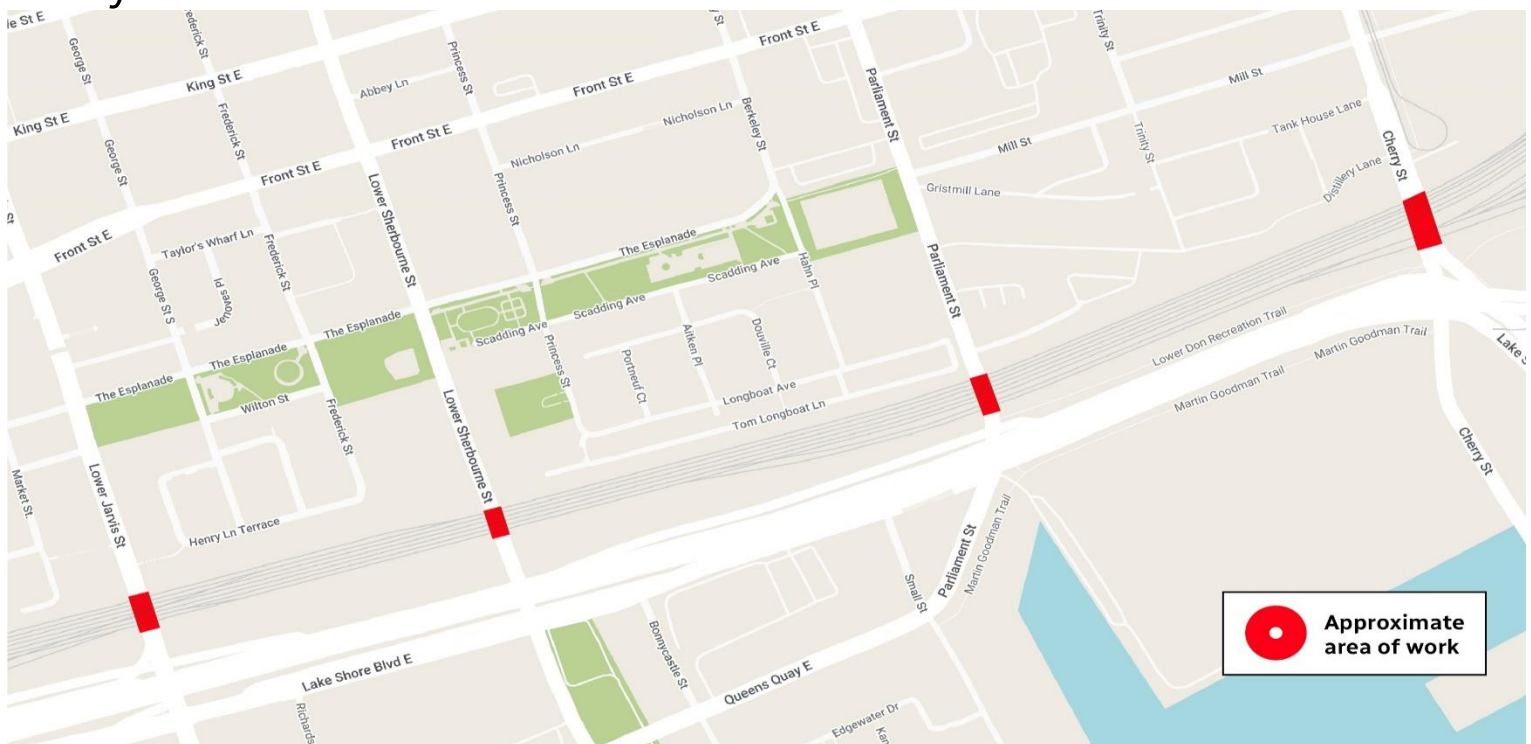


Overnight Temporary Lane and Sidewalk Closures: Lower Jarvis, Lower Sherbourne, Parliament and Cherry Street Bridges

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion On-Corridor Works project, crews will occupy a delineated section of Lower Jarvis, Lower Sherbourne, Parliament and Cherry Streets to conduct bridge inspections that support due diligence and investigations near the Union Station rail corridor. This work will support future track and infrastructure updates.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Inspectors will occupy north-south sidewalks, and northbound-southbound road and bike lanes to conduct bridge inspection activities at the following locations, on consecutive nights:
 - Jarvis St Bridge (16 Lower Jarvis St.)
 - Sherbourne St Bridge (7 Lower Sherbourne St.)
 - Parliament St Bridge (27 Parliament St.)
 - Cherry St Bridge (385 Cherry St.)
- At each location, one lane will remain open in each direction at all times for motorists, and one sidewalk will remain open at all times for pedestrians.
- Crews will occupy the sidewalk and curb lane to measure and inspect bridges using a manlift. Inspections will be conducted in the embankment or underside of the bridge and a manlift will be used to reach closely to the structure.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will take place overnight starting May 6 for 1 night at each location, on consecutive nights, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6 a.m. within the area highlighted on the map for several hours per night.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Temporary lane adjustments or closures may be required to complete this work safely.
- Signage and delineation will be installed as required to direct motorists around the work zones.
- Traffic control setup will be implemented, and a paid-duty officer will be present on-site at signalized intersections to direct traffic.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrians may be rerouted around work zones via delineated temporary detours.
- Pedestrians are encouraged to travel to detour along the opposite north-south sidewalk.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No anticipated impact on transit.
