
10-day Closure: Burloak Dr. between Harvester/Wyecroft Rds. and Prince William Dr./ Superior Court

PROJECT OVERVIEW


Metrolinx's GO Expansion program is delivering more GO service across the network, including trains every 15- minutes or better on the Lakeshore West Rail Corridor. To support GO Expansion, we are upgrading the rail network and our GO stations to enable more frequent and fully accessible service.

To support the increase in GO Service, Metrolinx is working with the City of Burlington and the Town of Oakville to build the grade separation (separation of the road from the rail corridor) at Burloak Drive. This work will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety and will optimize traffic flow at this crossing.

WHAT WORK IS TAKING PLACE?

Construction activity	Scheduled Start Date	Expected Duration	Work Hours	Description of Work
Preparation for track diversion	May 3, 2024	8 weeks	Day and night work; Friday to Sunday	Minor rail closures each weekend for: CN Rail protection Utility relocation Grading and drainage Track construction
Track relocation and shoring	June 14- 23, 2024	10 days	Day and night work; Monday - Sunday	Diverting tracks to allow for the construction of the grade separated junction. Caisson drilling and piling along the rail corridor and Burloak Drive.
Storm Sewer installation at Prince William Drive and Burloak Drive	June 14- 23, 2024	10 days	Day work; Monday - Friday (7am- 7pm)	Traffic control and site set-up. Excavation and installation of storm sewer. Testing, backfill, compaction and paving. Line painting and cleanup.

Work durations are approximate, work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- There will be a 10-day temporary full road closure on Burloak Drive from Harvester/Wyecroft Road to Prince William Drive/Superior Court. The sidewalk will also be closed.
- A storm sewer will be installed at the intersection of Burloak Drive and Prince William Drive. The intersection will remain open but the works will result in the restriction of certain traffic movements, appropriate signage will direct traffic.
- Surrounding residents and business will experience traffic disruptions, noise, dust, and vibration from the construction.
- Two temporary lanes one going in each direction, from Prince William Drive to the plaza at 700-728 Burloak Drive will be open, maintaining access to the businesses.

Contractors will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and businesses including but not limited to the following:

- Ongoing monitoring for noise and dust
- Regular sweeping of streets.
- Mud mats at site exit points to control and prevent dirt from leaving the site.
- Detour routes outlined during intersection closures with required signage.
- Limiting construction traffic and no parking on public streets
