

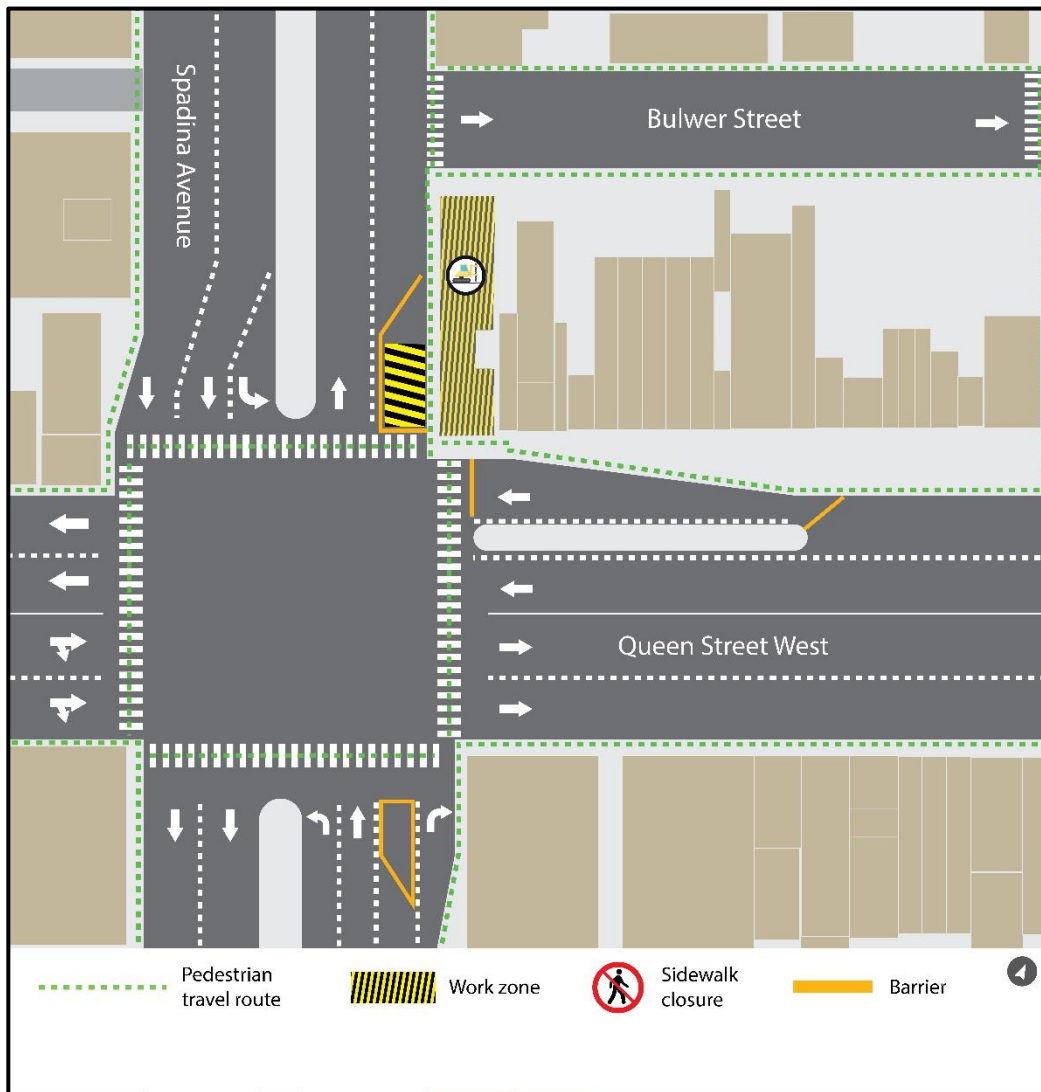
# Sewer disconnection works at Queen St W and Spadina Ave

**Expected start date:** As early as April 29, 2024

**Expected duration:** Approximately one week

**Hours of work:** Weekdays, overnight - 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

## What is happening?

- To prepare for construction of the future Ontario Line subway at Queen and Spadina, construction crews will be disconnecting sewers near the future North station site, on Spadina Avenue.
- To do this work, crews will access sewer manholes to assess the internal conditions of sewers and disconnect them from the City lines.
- Crews will drill into the road to disconnect the remaining utility to allow the piling works. Once complete, the drilled areas will be restored.

## What can I expect?

- This work is expected to start as early as April 29, 2024.
- Crews are expected to work during weekday shifts, overnight from 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Additional hours of work may be required.

- On Spadina Avenue, lane restrictions will be in place while crews are working in the area, as highlighted in the map above.
- Pedestrian access through the area is expected to be maintained during this work as indicated on the map above.
- Barriers will be in place to separate the work zone from active traffic.
- There are no expected impacts to transit services, and access to local residential and commercial units will be maintained.
- A hydro-vacuum truck and excavator will be required to safely carry out this work due to the limited space between the construction area and the existing buried utilities.
- Some noise may occur from construction equipment.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be postponed, rescheduled, dates changed, or hours added due to unforeseen circumstances.
