

UPDATED: Completion of long-term lane closures on Manitoba Drive

Expected start date: As early as May 1, 2024

Expected duration of : Until May 10, 2024

Hours of work: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.



What is happening?

- To make way for the future Ontario Line station on the Exhibition grounds, street, and sidewalk closures have been in place at approximately 200 Manitoba Drive, west of Nova Scotia Drive, over the winter and early spring months to ensure safety and expedite work on the grounds.
- Crews successfully relocated hydroelectric system utilities directly south of the Gardiner Expressway, in the vicinity of the Food Building on the Exhibition Grounds.

- This work which involved creating a trench along the alignment of Manitoba Drive, for placement of utilities. This work is now complete.
- Work crews will be grading and repaving the road surface on Manitoba Drive as early as May 1 through May 10.

Traffic and pedestrian details

- The work areas (adjacent to 200 Manitoba Drive) will continue to be barriered from pedestrians and vehicles, including closure of the north sidewalk until the repaving is complete.
- One traffic lane for both east/west travel will remain open on Manitoba Drive.
- Temporary signals will remain in place, and direction of travel will be controlled based on signal.
- The work area will remain fenced off until the road work is complete, to prevent trespassing on site.
- A signal person will be on site as needed to direct traffic and pedestrians.
- Pedestrians may still access Exhibition GO, the TTC streetcar loop, Coca-Cola Coliseum, BMO Field and the Enercare Centre without detour.

What to expect?

- Repaving of the road adjacent to 200 Manitoba Drive, as well as noise from paving machinery such as rollers, pavers, tampers, trucks and other equipment will occur.
- Work may be delayed, rescheduled, or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
- All the necessary permits have been obtained.
