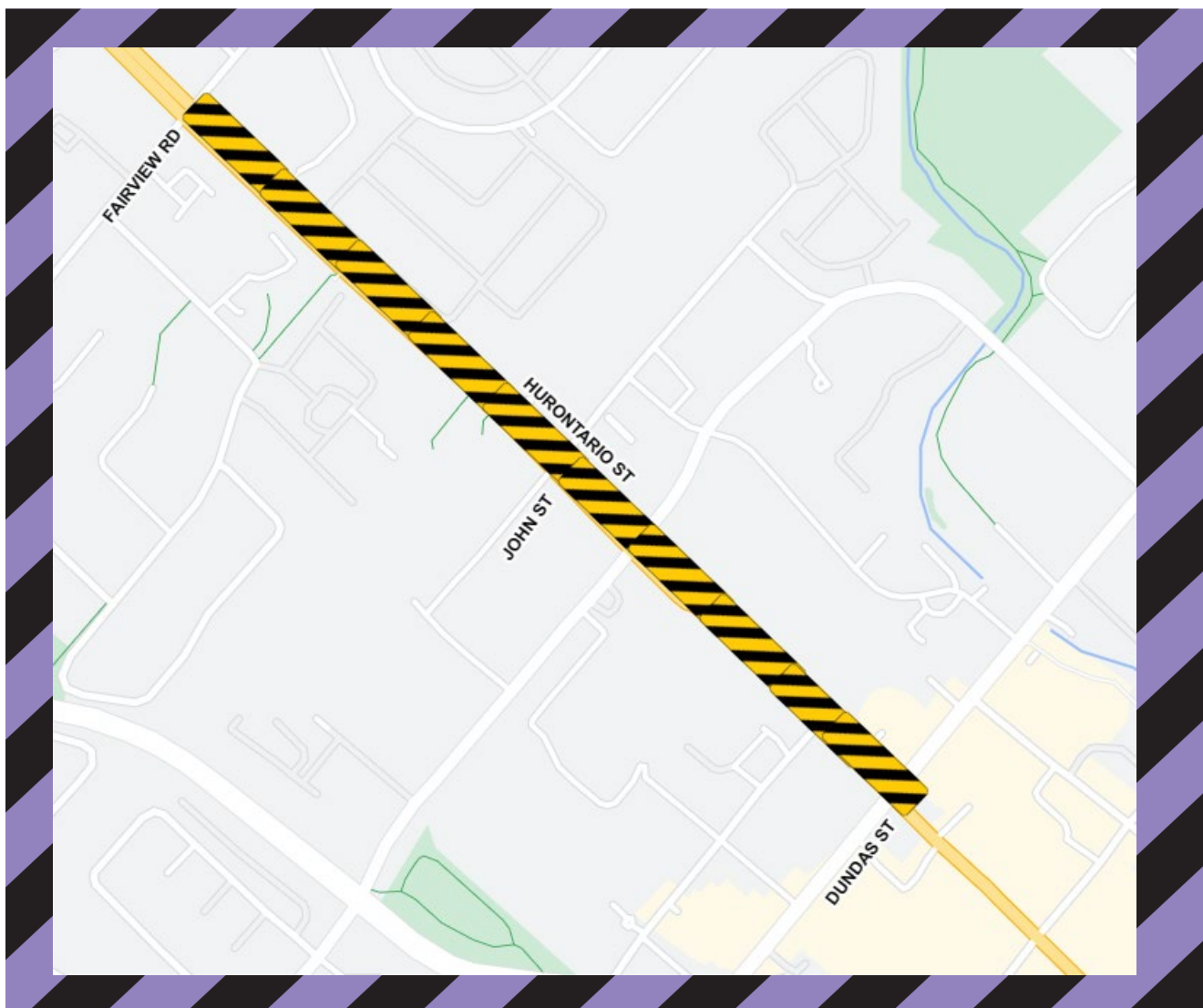


Nightworks on Hurontario Street from Dundas Street to Fairview Road

Friday May 10 to Monday May 13, 2024; 24 hrs at Fairview Road

Saturday May 11, 2024; 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. at John Street

Monday May 13 to Friday May 31, 2024; 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.



What work is taking place?

As utility upgrades progress in the area, crews will be installing water service connections and stormwater infrastructure on Hurontario Street from Dundas Street to Fairview Road.

- Work is scheduled for 24 hours from May 10 to May 13, 2024 at Fairview Road and Hurontario Street.
- Work is scheduled on May 11, 2024 from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- From May 13 to May 31, 2024 the work hours are scheduled from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on some nights. Some temporary lane closures and turning restrictions will be required during this work.

All work is being done overnight so crews will be able to complete them safely and efficiently while minimizing impacts. In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- 24 hour works are scheduled at Fairview Road and Hurontario Street from May 10-13, 2024.
- Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. at John Street and Hurontario Street on May 11, 2024.
- Work is scheduled from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on some nights during May 13 to May 31, 2024 on Hurontario Street between Dundas Street and Fairview Road.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Some temporary lane closures and turning restrictions will be required during this work.
- Emergency access will be maintained.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Please watch for bus stops that are relocated during the nightworks.

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours will be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety
