

Overnight Work north of Hurontario and Hwy 403

Tuesday May 7, 2024 and Friday May 10, 2024

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Traction powered substation (TPSS) units are required to channel power to the light rail vehicles for the Hazel McCallion Line. Construction crews are conducting work for the TPSS unit just north of the Highway 403 on Hurontario Street. To complete these works safely with minimal traffic impacts, crews will operate on two nights.

The delivery of the TPSS unit will be on **Tuesday, May 7, 2024, from midnight to 3 a.m.** During the delivery, nearby traffic will be temporarily impacted. Crews will later have to conduct storm sewer installation work in the same area on **Friday, May 10, 2024, 2024 from 7 p.m to 7 a.m.**

Metrolinx has a noise bylaw exemption for this overnight work, however every effort will be made to minimize disruptions. Residents near the work site may hear noise or feel vibrations caused by construction vehicles and equipment, and hauling of materials.
