

Overnight Installation of Control Points near the Union Station Rail Corridor

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion On-Corridor Works project, surveyors will temporarily occupy delineated sections of sidewalks from Cherry Street to Hanna Avenue to set up survey control points to support investigative works near the Union Station rail corridor. This work will support future track and infrastructure updates for the GO Expansion program.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Surveyors will temporarily occupy sidewalks throughout the downtown core from Cherry Street in the east to Hanna Avenue in the west to support the creation of a coordinate system by creating control points and measuring elevations at selected locations near the Union Station Rail Corridor.
- Using digital equipment and hand tools, markers will be installed, and crews will measure land elevations from existing benchmarks to onsite control points.
- Sidewalks will remain open; pedestrians will be detoured around temporary work zones via delineation barriers.
- Directional signage will be installed as required.
- If required, site lighting will be pointed away from residences.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will take place overnight Monday - Friday from 10:00 p.m. to 6 a.m., beginning May 21, 2024.
- Work will progress in stages within the areas highlighted on the map for approximately 8 weeks.
- Work may be scheduled for daytime or overnight hours.
- Surveying is sequenced and moves throughout the highlighted areas as work progresses.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- No anticipated impact on traffic.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Pedestrians will be rerouted around work zones via delineated barriers. Directional signage will be installed as required.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- No anticipated impact on transit.
