

UPDATED: New hoarding installation at King and Bathurst

Expected start date: As early as April 10, 2024

Expected duration: April 10 through June 10, 2024

Hours of work: Daily from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- As part of ongoing construction of the Ontario Line and the future King-Bathurst Station, crews will be installing long-term hoarding around both north and south site footprints. This work will take place as of April 3, 2024.
- Once complete, the hoarding will be painted and branded, to ensure a clean and aesthetically appealing construction site, as Metrolinx strives to be a good neighbour. This work is done entirely within the King-Bathurst construction sites, and will not impact traffic, vehicles, or pedestrian traffic foot traffic.
- Area residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from work equipment, specifically the assembly of plywood panels and materials being unloaded from trucks.
- Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.

What to expect

- Starting in the afternoon of April 3, crews will be working to remove the temporary fencing at King-Bathurst and replacing it with long-term hoarding, as an enhanced site safety measure.
- There will be no lane or pedestrian barriers as the long-term hoarding is installed. Equipment such as trucks, cargo vans will be in place to a loading truck.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
