
# Update: Weekend work for demolition of buildings near Pape Station

**Expected start date:** Ongoing

**Expected duration:** Until late June 2024

Hours of work: Monday - Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.



### What is happening?

• To accommodate construction activities for the Ontario Line, crews are demolishing the properties outlined in the map above. These buildings are Metrolinx-owned properties near Pape Station.

- On Monday, February 12, 2024, crews began the demolition of the buildings on the south side of Gertrude Place, the south side of Lipton Ave, the west side of Eaton Ave between Lipton Ave and Danforth Ave, and on the north side of Danforth Ave between Eaton Ave and 670 Danforth Ave.
- The buildings have been prepared for demolition with the removal of interior details.
- Following demolition, crews will be preparing the site for future use by backfilling the soil and compacting it. Vibrations from these activities can be expected.
- **Update:** All work will take place Monday to **Saturday** between 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for approximately five (5) months.

# What to Expect

- During demolition, noise from construction equipment including excavators, bobcats, and dump trucks can be expected.
- Vibration from compaction rollers can be expected. This helps the soil settle into place during compaction.
- Short-term traffic interruptions can be expected while trucks and equipment enter and exit work zones; traffic control personnel will be present to direct vehicles and pedestrians.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to delineate work zones.
- There will be no impacts to TTC bus or subway service from this work.
- This work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.

# About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 40 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
