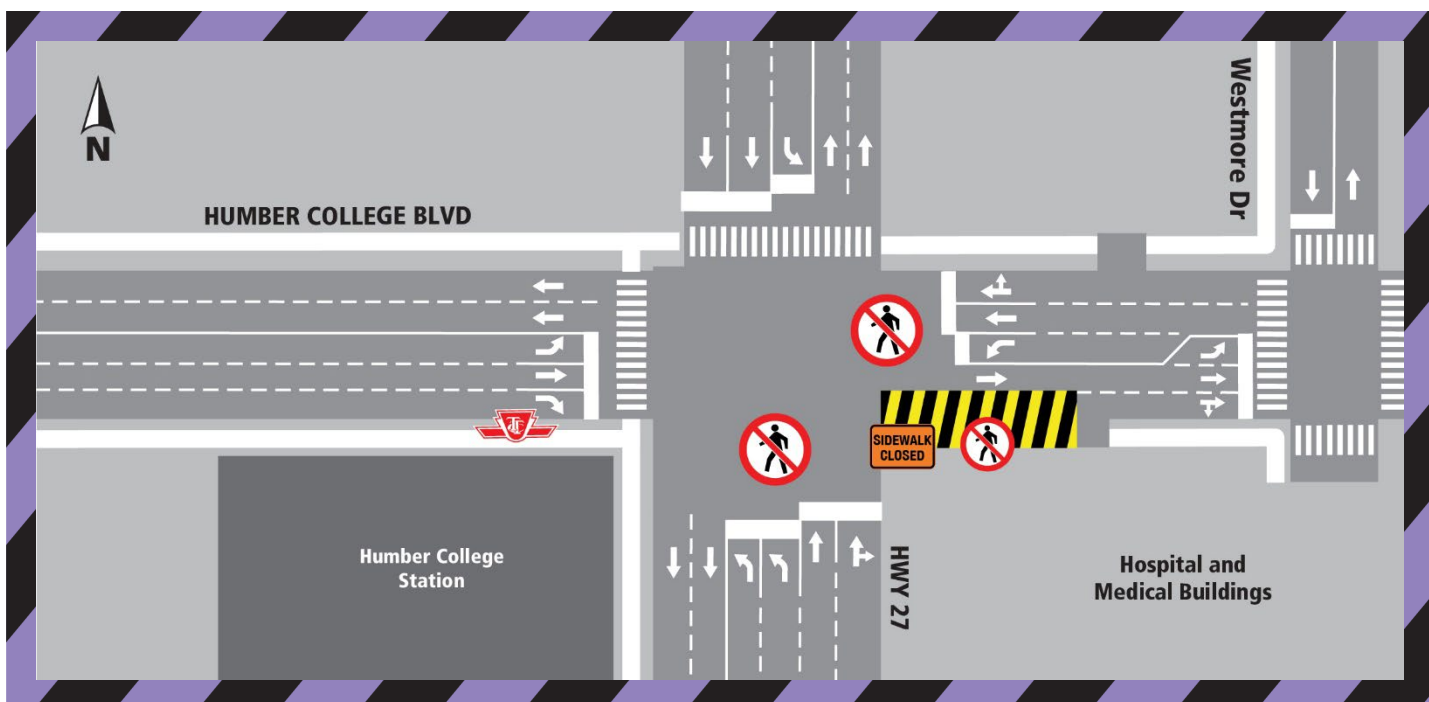


Update: Minor Works at Humber College Boulevard and Hwy 27

May 8, 2024 to June 14, 2024



Map 1 Description: Humber College Boulevard and Hwy 27. Sidewalk works starting May 8, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately.

TIMING

- Sidewalk works: May 8, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately (Map 1)
- Curb works: May 29, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately (Map 2)
- Sidewalk works: May 22, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approximately (Map 3)
- Dates are tentative and may change.
- Work hours: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- There may be overnight and/or weekend work, if required.

IMPACT

- Short-term lane closures.
- Minor pedestrian detours.
- Temporary relocation of TTC bus stops, if needed.
- Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

LOCATION

- Humber College Boulevard and Hwy 27.

WORK DESCRIPTION

- Minor sidewalk and curb works.

Detailed Description

As part of the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project, crews will be performing minor sidewalk and curb works at Humber College Boulevard and Hwy 27.

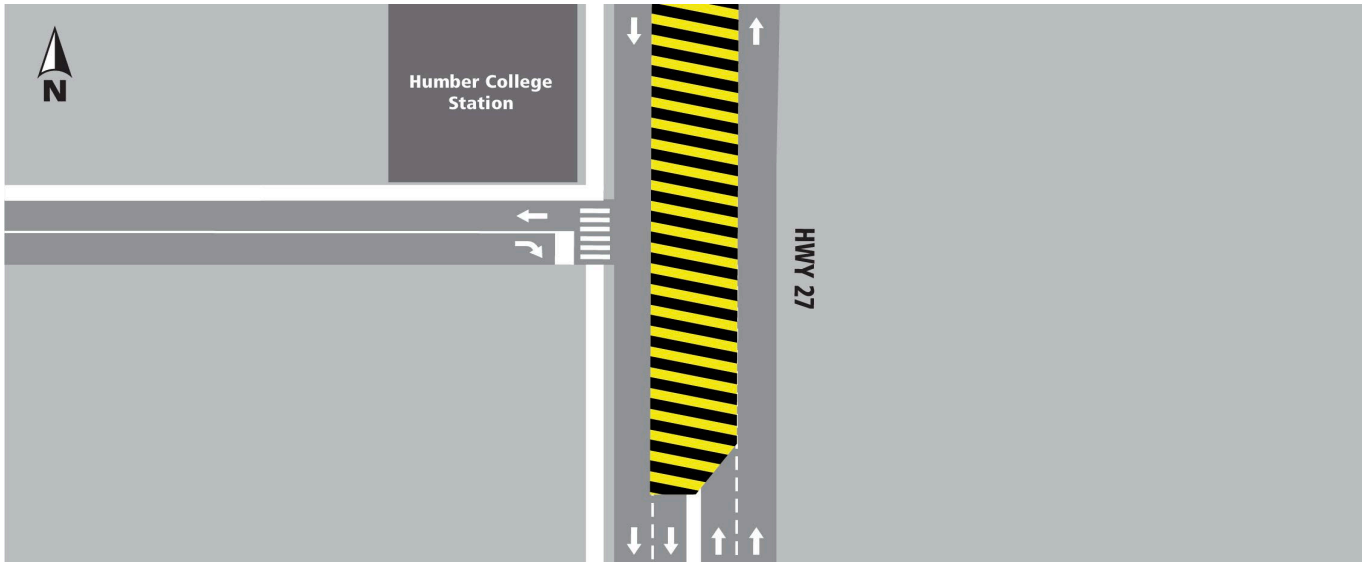
The work started on May 8, 2024, and will last till June 14, 2024, approximately.

Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

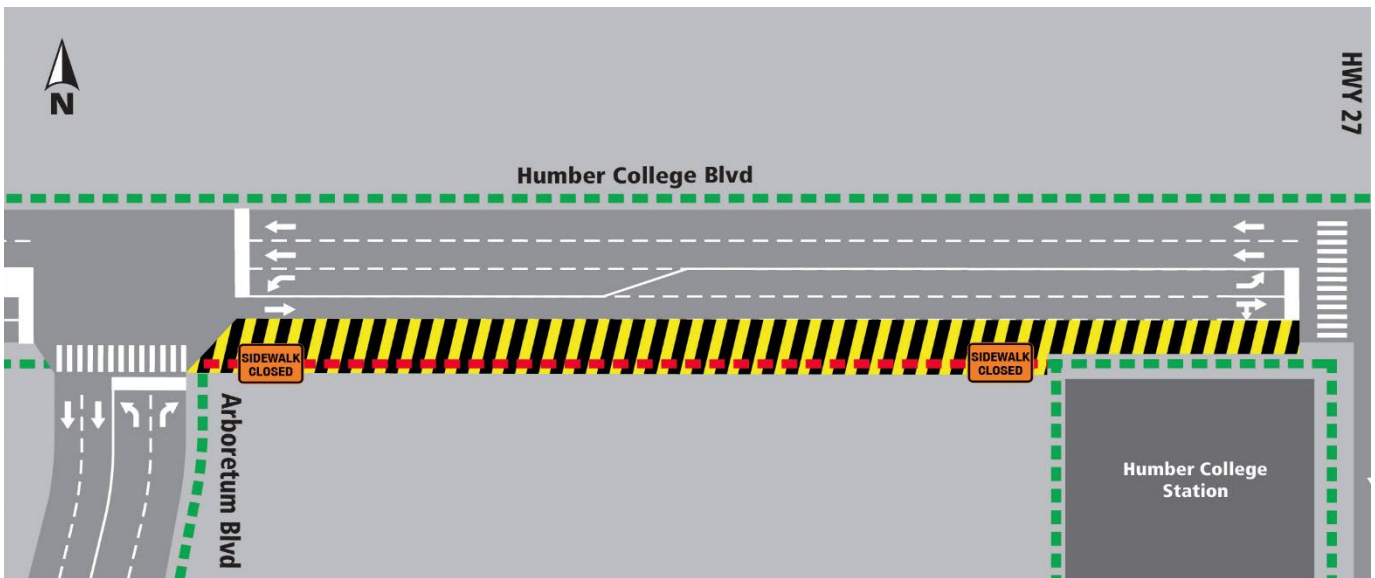
Please take extra care when navigating near work sites, and always make eye contact with the any driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle as it is accessing or egressing the active work zone. Please also comply with instructions from site crews and follow the dedicated pedestrian routes. Please do not enter into any areas with active construction operations.

Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

Noise and vibration will be monitored when required during these activities.



Map 2 Description: Humber College Boulevards and Hwy 27. Northbound left turn into Humber Access Road will be closed for curb works starting May 29, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately.



Map 3 Description: Humber College Boulevard. Sidewalk works starting May 22, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approximately.

WORK HOURS:

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be overnight and/or weekend work 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., if required.
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about the closure.
- Dates are tentative and may change. Please visit us at www.metrolinx.com/finchwestlrt for up-to-date information.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Due to the nature of the work, at times there will be dust, noise and vibration associated with this work.
- Nearby businesses and residents can expect noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks, and other construction equipment caused by road work activities.
- Expect delays near work zones.
- A minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Avenue West will be always maintained.
- There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs to direct traffic, as needed.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS:

- Road and sidewalk restrictions are in place within the construction area to protect workers and the public.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Pedestrians will be re-routed around the construction area when possible. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be diverted to the sidewalk on the opposite side.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated away from work zones, as needed.
- Relocation of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC.
- Access to TTC will be always maintained, please visit www.ttc.ca for more information.
