What You Need to Know

Starting June 17 to June 21 between 9pm to 5am. Night maintenance work will be performed on the railway bridge to replace a section of the concrete slab above the eastbound traffic lane. During this period, eastbound vehicular traffic will be closed at night. The proposed work involves installing a new section of precast concrete slab, which will be lifted into place.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- The work will be conducted above road level. maintaining a minimum distance of one meter from TTC overhead cables and tracks to ensure the safe passage of any TTC streetcars in service.
- Paid duty officers will be present at the site location during the night shifts to direct traffic.
- The repair will take place at the southwest corner of the bridge.
- Tower lights will be set up at the bridge location to illuminate the work area.
- Noise levels may be elevated in the areas surrounding the work locations.
- Some noise will be generated from small tools and the engine mufflers of the telehandler used to lift the concrete panel.
- Our teams always work hard to minimize community impacts.

Work will take place during the night from June 17-June 21. from 9:00PM- 5:00AM at the Railway bridge across St. Clair Avenue West (between Keele and Old Weston Road)
