Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

To support GO Expansion projects, crews will be mobilizing to take overhead utilities and transfer them underground to remove overhead cable conflicts over the Metrolinx Kitchener corridor.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will be on site to take overhead utilities and transfer them underground to remove overhead cable conflict over the Metrolinx KT corridor to support GO Expansion projects.
- Crews will be on site beginning **June 15th, 2024**.
- There will also be temporary lane closures from June 15th, as detailed below under Traffic Details.
- Crews will be working within the city right-of-way.
- Please Note: The work start date is tentative and may be rescheduled due to a variety of factors. Please reach out to the Toronto Community Engagement Team for any questions.

HOURS OF WORK

- Crews will be on site between the hours of 7am to 6pm.
- Standard construction noise will remain within the allowable municipal by-law limits.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be temporary lane closures at Lawrence Avenue, Pine Street, and Wright Avenue.
- This will occur from June 15th until the end of the year.
- There will be signage setup to notify residents of the road closure and to detours around the works.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There will be some impact to residents along Lawrence Avenue West, Pine Street and Wright Avenue as crews will be excavating within the City right-of-way.
- Residents will still be able to access Lawrence Avenue West, Pine Street and Wright Avenue throughout the construction via the pedestrian crossing on the opposite side.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- There are no anticipated transit impacts from the upcoming works.
