
Pedestrian detour at 1 Queen Street East

Expected start date: As early as June 2, 2024 **Expected duration:** Up to December 2024

What is happening?

As part of construction activities for the Ontario Line station at Queen, the sidewalk in front of 1 Queen Street East will be temporarily closed. During the closure, pedestrians will be detoured through the 1 Queen Street East building. The emergency exit from 1 Queen Street East will be kept clear at all times.

This detour is anticipated to last approximately six months. Occasionally, some of the sidewalk may reopen temporarily during the works.

What to expect

- The closure is expected to begin as early as June 2, 2024, and is expected to be in place for approximately six months. Portions of the sidewalk may reopen temporarily as work allows.
- During this time, pedestrians will be detoured through the 1 Queen Street East building.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.

Note:

- Work may be delayed, rescheduled, or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
