

Drilling work near Jane Street to support future tunnel portal construction

Expected timeline: June 18th, 2024 - Fall 2024

Work hours: Weekdays and weekends, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

What is happening?

• Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be carrying out drilling work in the area marked on the map above to support future construction of the eastern underground segment of the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension.

What to expect

- The work involves installing support structures and systems to accommodate construction of the tunnel portal and the construction of the future tunnel, east of Jane Street, that will connect the extension to the future Eglinton Crosstown LRT service at Mount Dennis Station.
- Support structures like steel piles will lay the foundation for the tunnel and portal and will help make sure the ground is stable and secure for future excavations and construction.
- Drilling equipment will be used to twist steel casings into the ground to dig holes.
- Soil will be removed, and the casings filled with steel piles and concrete.
- After piling work is completed, tunneling will begin.
- Some noise, vibration, and dust can be expected near the construction site during work hours.
- Measures will be taken to minimize disruptions wherever possible.
- Noise, vibration, and dust monitors will be used 24/7.
- Work may be scheduled outside regular work hours, as required.
- Work may be delayed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- A temporary bi-directional cycle path and pedestrian walkway will be open for use on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West during construction.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to the region, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometers from the future Mount Dennis LRT station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
