
# Update:Temporary Traffic Changes at Sentinel Road, Romfield Lane, Keele Street and Tangiers Road on Finch Avenue West

February 5, 2024 to June 14, 2024



Map 1 Description: Keele Street to Tangiers Road and Finch Avenue West. Sidewalk works from February 5, 2024 untill May 31, 2024, approximately.

### TIMING

- Map 1: Keele Street to Tangiers Road. Sidewalk works from February 5, 2024, to May 31, 2024, approx.
- Map 2: Sentinel Road and Finch Avenue West. Sidewalk works from May 7, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approx.
- Map 3: Keele Street at Finch Avenue West. Sidewalk works from May 23, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately; Northwest corner of Romfield Lane intersection along Finch Avenue West from May 29, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately; Utilities works southeast corner of Keele Street. Starting June 3, 2024 for two (2) weeks, approximately.
- Work hours: 7.am. to 5 p.m., approximately.
- There may be overnight and/or weekend work, if needed.

# LOCATION

• Sentinel Road, Romfield Lane, Keele Street, Tangiers Road on Finch Avenue West.

### IMPACT

- Rolling temporary lane closures.
- Periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures.
- Temporary relocation of TTC bus stops, if needed.
- Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

#### WORK DESCRIPTION

- Dry and wet utility works.
- Sidewalk, curb, and road works.


# **Detailed Description**

As part of the preparatory works for the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) line crews will be doing wet and dry utilities works, sidewalk, curb, and road works at Sentinel Road, Romfield Lane, Keele Street and Tangiers Road on Finch Avenue West. The works started on February 5, 2024, and will last till June 14, 2024, approximately. Notice will be updated as required to reflect any significant traffic staging.


Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Please take extra care when navigating near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public. Noise and vibration will be monitored when required during these activities.



Map 2 Description: Sentinel Road and Finch Avenue West. Sidewalk works from May 7, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approximately.



Map 3 Description: Keele Street at Finch Avenue West. Sidewalk works starting May 23, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately; Sidewalk works along Finch Avenue West, northwest corner of Romfield Lane intersection. Starting May 29, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately; Utilities works southeast corner of Keele Street. Starting June 3, 2024, for two (2) weeks, approximately.

## **WORK HOURS:**

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be overnight and/or weekend work 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., if required.
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about the closure.
- Dates are tentative and may change. Please visit us at www.metrolinx.com/finchwestlrt for up-to-date information.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Due to the nature of the work, at times there will be dust, noise and vibration associated with this work.
- Nearby businesses and residents can expect noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks, and other construction equipment caused by road work activities.
- Expect delays near work zones.
- A minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Avenue West will be always maintained.
- There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs to direct traffic, as needed.

#### PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS:

- Road and sidewalk restrictions are in place within the construction area to protect workers and the public.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Pedestrians will be re-routed around the construction area when possible. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be diverted to the sidewalk on the opposite side.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated away from work zones, as needed.
- Relocation of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC.
- Access to TTC will be always maintained, please visit www.ttc.ca for more information.
