
Update: Temporary Traffic Changes Between Signet Drive and Milvan Drive on Finch Avenue West

January 15, 2024 to June 25, 2024



Map Description: Signet Dr./ Arrow Rd. and Finch Ave. W. Sidewalk works southeast corner of Arrow Road and Finch Avenue West, starting May 31, 2024, to June 7, 2024, approximately; Right in right out on to Finch Avenue West. Road work starting June 8 - 11, 2024, approximately.

TIMING

- January 15, 2024, to June 25, 2024, approximately.
- Work hours: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- There may be overnight and/or weekend work, if required.

IMPACT

- Right In right out at Signet Drive/Arrow Road on to Finch Avenue West.
- Rolling temporary lane closures.
- Periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures.
- Temporary relocation of TTC bus stops, if needed.
- Temporary driveway closures will be implements as needed. Access to properties will remain at all times.
- Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

LOCATION

• Between Signet Drive to Milvan Drive on Finch Avenue West.

WORK DESCRIPTION

- Sidewalk, curb, grading and road works
- Dry and wet utilities works.

Detailed Description


As part of the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project, crews will be doing sidewalk, curb, grading, road works and wet and dry utilities works along Finch Avenue West between Signet Drive and Milvan Drive. Notice will be updated as required to reflect any significant traffic staging along Finch Avenue West between Signet Drive and Milvan Drive.

The work started on January 15, 2024, and will last till June 25, 2024, approximately.


Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Please take extra care when navigating near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public. Noise and vibration will be monitored when required during these activities.

Map Description: Weston Road and Finch Avenue West. Temporary driveway closures will be implements as needed. Access to properties will remain at all times. Sidewalk works starting May 27, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approximately.




Map Description: Milvan Dr./Rumike Rd. and Finch Ave. W. Utilities works May 30 - 31, 2024, approximately.

Map Description: Jayzel Dr. and Finch Ave. W. Northside starting May 21, 2024, for two (2) weeks; Southside starting May 27, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approximately.

WORK HOURS:

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There may be overnight and/or weekend work, if required.
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about the closure.
- Dates are tentative and may change. Please visit us at www.metrolinx.com/finchwestlrt for up-to-date information.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Due to the nature of the work, at times there will be dust, noise and vibration associated with this work.
- Nearby businesses and residents can expect noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks, and other construction equipment caused by road work activities.
- Expect delays near work zones.
- A minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Avenue West will be always maintained.
- There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs to direct traffic, as needed.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS:

- Road and sidewalk restrictions are in place within the construction area to protect workers and the public.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Pedestrians will be re-routed around the construction area when possible. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be diverted to the sidewalk on the opposite side.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated away from work zones, as needed.
- Relocation of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC.
