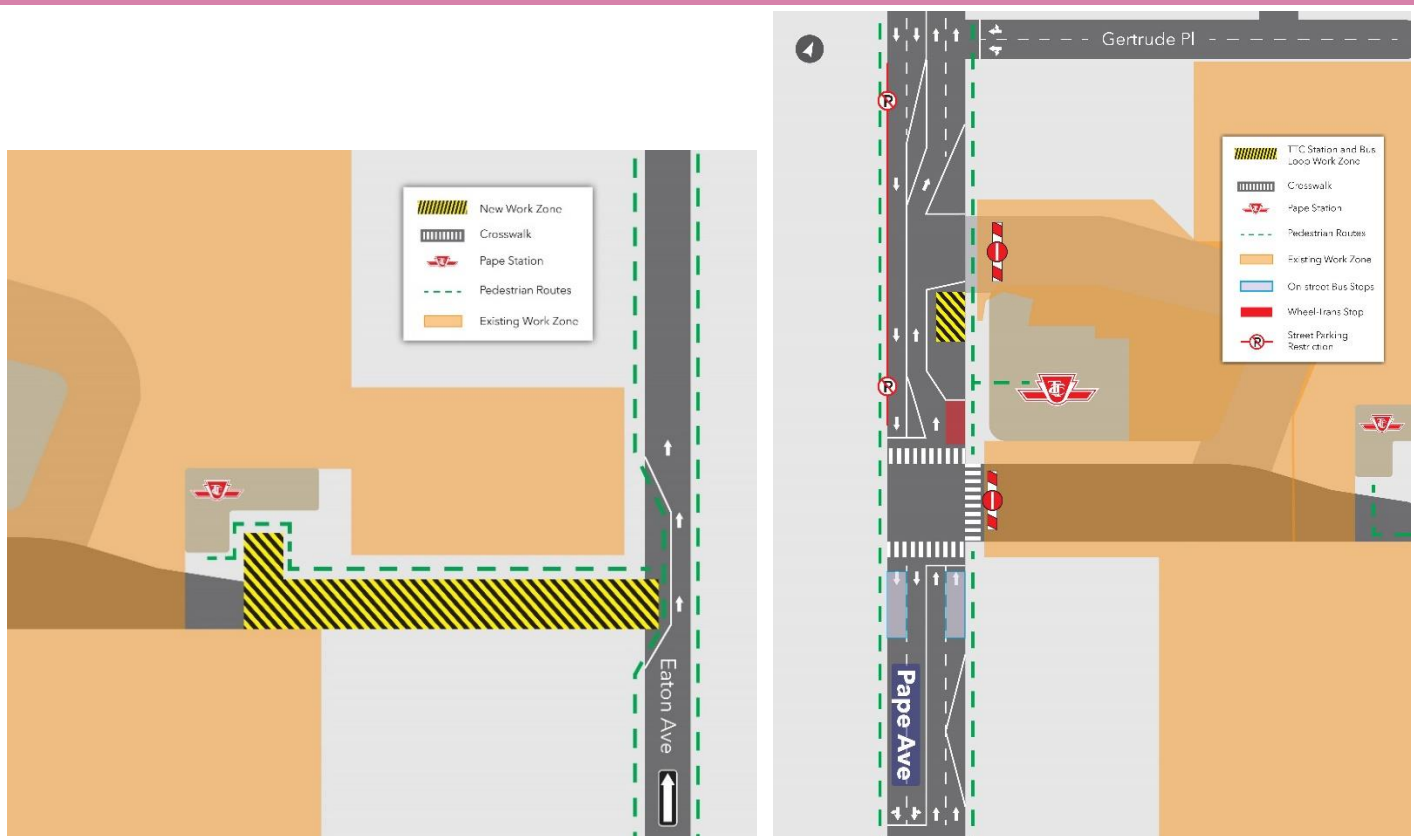


Water Main and Storm Sewer Replacement near Pape Station

Expected start date: As early as June 17, 2024

Duration: Approximately three (3) weeks

Hours of work: Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m



Work Zone 1 - Eaton Avenue

Work Zone 2 - Pape Avenue

What is happening?

- To facilitate major construction at Pape Station for the Ontario Line, crews will be relocating a water main on Eaton Avenue (Work Zone 1) and a storm sewer on Pape Avenue (Work Zone 2).
- This work will take place concurrently with the ongoing bus loop closure and associated TTC station work, and will last approximately three weeks.
- Work will take place between Monday and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

What to expect

- This work will take place in two separate work zones.
- **Zone 1 (figure 1 - Eaton Avenue) details:**
 - A work zone will be established stretching from the eastern Pape Station entrance through the walkway towards Eaton Avenue, and occupying the western half of Eaton Avenue.
 - Eaton Avenue will remain open with traffic being allowed to continue northbound on the east side of the street.
 - Pedestrian access to the east Pape Station entrance will be maintained.
 - Pedestrian access on the west side of Eaton Avenue will be maintained by routing around the work zone into the centre of the road.
 - This stage will begin as early as June 17.
- **Zone 2 (figure 2 - Pape Avenue) details:**
 - A work zone will be established in the eastern half of Pape Avenue in front of the TTC Station entrance.
 - Traffic will merge into one lane in each direction on the west side of Pape Avenue.
 - The TTC temporary on-street bus stops will be shifted to south of the Pape-Lipton intersection.
 - A wheel-trans stop will be maintained on the north side of the Pape-Lipton intersection.
 - Street parking will be restricted on the west side of Pape between Lipton and Gertrude.
 - This stage will begin as early as June 24.
- Work will involve the use of excavators and hydrovac trucks.
- All work will take place from Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Pape Station will remain open and accessible for TTC subway service during this work.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
