
Update: Temporary Traffic Changes Between Martin Grove Road and Albion Road at Finch Avenue West

May 13, 2024 to June 21, 2024



Map 1 Description: Martin Grove Road and Finch Avenue West. Road and curb works. May 13, 2024 for three (3) weeks, approximately.

TIMING

- Map 1: Road and curb works; May 13, 2024, for three (3) weeks, approximately.
- Map 2: Road and curb works; Stage 1, May 13, 2024, to May 27, 2024, approximately; Stage 2, May 28 to June 11, 2024, approximately.
- Map 3: Curb works; June 17, 2024, for one (1) week, approximately.
- Work hours: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., approximately.
- Dates are tentative and may change.
- There may be overnight and/or weekend work, if required.

IMPACT

- There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers to direct traffic, as needed.
- Temporary relocation of TTC bus stops, if needed.
- Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

LOCATION

 Between Martin Grove Road and Albion Road at Finch Avenue West

WORK DESCRIPTION

• Road and curb works.

Detailed Description

As part of the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project, crews will be doing utilities, road and curb works between Martin Grove Road and Albion Road at Finch Avenue West. Notice will be updated as required to reflect any significant traffic staging.

The work started on May 13, 2024, and will last till June 21, 2024, approximately.


Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Please take extra care when navigating near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.


There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs to direct traffic, as needed.

Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

Noise and vibration will be monitored when required during these activities.



Map 2 Description: Martin Grove Road to Albion Road along Finch Avenue West. Road and curb works. Stage 1, May 13 – 27, 2024, approximately, and Stage 2, May 28 – June 11, approximately.



Map 3 Description: Albion Mall at Finch Avenue West. Curb works starting June 17, 2024, and will last for one (1) week, approximately.

WORK HOURS:

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be overnight and/or weekend work 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., if required.
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about the closure.
- Dates are tentative and may change. Please visit us at www.metrolinx.com/finchwestlrt for up-to-date information.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.

WHAT TO EXPECT.

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Due to the nature of the work, at times there will be dust, noise and vibration associated with this work.
- Nearby businesses and residents can expect noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks, and other construction equipment caused by road work activities.
- Expect delays near work zones.
- A minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Avenue West will be always maintained.
- There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs to direct traffic, as needed.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS:

- Road and sidewalk restrictions are in place within the construction area to protect workers and the public.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Pedestrians will be re-routed around the construction area when possible. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be diverted to the sidewalk on the opposite side.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated away from work zones, as needed.
- Relocation of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC.
- Access to TTC will be always maintained, please visit www.ttc.ca for more information.
