# King City GO: Sheet Piling Installation Underground

# **Project Overview**

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections.

Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

### What You Need to Know

Metrolinx is continuing to make progress on upgrades to the Barrie rail corridor in support of GO Expansion! In May, we installed a temporary platform that allows for easier removals and access to the ground below.

During this upcoming weekend shutdown of the Barrie Line, we will temporarily remove the platform and install sheet piling underground. This will prevent any moisture from entering the soil and help prevent the ground from caving in for future culvert work under the tracks.

These improvements will further us towards the future goal of increasing service at King City GO and across the Barrie line and get you where you need to go faster and easier by preparing the platform for future expansion to two tracks.

## What to expect

Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration from the use of heavy construction equipment including hydraulic excavators, loaders, dozers, and other machinery.

Customers should be aware that GO trains will not be in service along the Barrie line during the work period. Please be sure to check our website: https://www.gotransit.com/en/plan-your-trip for bus schedules to plan accordingly.

We understand that we are conducting work near a residential area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.
