

Chapman Street Track State of Good Repair (East of Old Yonge Street, East Gwillimbury)

July 5, 2024 at 8:00p.m. to July 8, 2024 at 5:00a.m.



What is happening?

As a part of the corridor maintenance program, construction will take place at the railway track crossing at Chapman Street in East Gwillimbury, in the Barrie rail corridor, to support infrastructure and corridor maintenance.

What does this mean for you?

From Friday, July 5th to Monday, July 8th 2024, Metrolinx contractors will be performing a full railway crossing rehabilitation. They will be removing and replacing the ballast, and installing a new track panel, concrete, and asphalt.

Work will begin on Friday July 5, 2024 at 8:00 p.m. and continue throughout the weekend until Monday July 8, 2024 at 5:00 a.m.

Chapman Street South will be **closed at the track crossing** in order to facilitate the work. The railway will not be affected.

To accommodate residents on Chapman Street South who require vehicle access, parking will be available in the curb lane on Chapman Street, north of the railway line. A flagman will be in place to ensure pedestrian safety at the railway crossing.

Nearby residents may experience noise from the use of construction machinery and equipment required to safely complete this work, including a surfacing tamper and ballast regulator. However, equipment will be outfitted with a white noise back-up alarm to ensure that noise levels are kept as low as possible.

Every effort will be made to minimize disruption. We understand that we are conducting rail maintenance in a residential area and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this critical work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.
