Overnight weekend utility work near the Don Yard

Hours of work: Friday July 12 starting at 8 p.m. until Monday July 15 at 4 a.m.



What is happening?

- During the weekend of Friday July 12 Monday July 15, utility relocation work will take place within the Don Yard (work areas shown on the map above).
- Utility relocations are required to realign the existing railway tracks and make way for the future Ontario Line subway.
- Excavators, hydro-vacuum trucks, and other construction equipment will be used to complete this work.



- Utility relocations must be completed overnight when trains are not running to avoid impacts to GO train services.
- This work will start at 8p.m. on Friday July 12 and is expected to continue until Monday July 15, 2024.
- All work will take place from within the rail corridor; no traffic or pedestrian closures are expected.

What to expect

- Noise from construction equipment including an excavator and hydro-vacuum truck.
- A hydro-vacuum truck will be required to safely carry out some work due to the limited space between the construction area and the existing buried utilities.
- Crews must use hydro-vac equipment when working within two meters of buried utilities to ensure public and worker safety and protect the utilities from damage.
- Trucks will enter and exit the site via Mill Street east of Bayview Avenue.
- Noise mitigation measures will be implemented as required during the day and overnight.
- The existing train tracks will be realigned to make way for the new Ontario Line subway.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
