
Partial closure of laneway east of Pape Avenue at Sammon Avenue

Start date: As early as Monday, July 15, 2024

Expected duration: Until end of 2024



What is happening?

- As early as Monday, July 15, 2024, the northern half of the laneway east of Pape Avenue between Sammon Avenue and Aldwych Avenue will be closed. This is being done so that the slurry storage silos can be moved into the laneway to allow a larger space for operations onsite.
- The laneway will remain accessible via the entrance on Aldwych Avenue, but there will be no vehicle or pedestrian access to Sammon Avenue. All driveways and residences connected to the laneway will remain accessible.
- The closure will be in place until the end of 2024.
- Existing traffic restrictions in the area will continue to allow for construction. Past construction notices can be found online by visiting <u>www.metrolinx.com/ontarioline</u> and clicking on "Notices".

What to expect

- There will be a partial closure of the northern section of the laneway east of Pape Avenue between Sammon Avenue and Aldwych Avenue.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- The noise wall located on the east side of the site will not be repositioned, as the silos which will be moved into the laneway do not generate noise.
- During mobilization, construction equipment will access the laneway to perform site setup.
- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to outline work zones.
- Work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- This laneway closure has been approved by the City of Toronto.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
