

Temporary Driveway Closures on Hurontario from north of Inglewood Drive to Indian Valley Trail

Friday July 5 to Friday July 31, 2024



Project Overview

The Hazel McCallion LRT (HM LRT) project will be an 18-kilometre, 19-stop light rail service connecting people from the Port Credit GO station to the Brampton Gateway Terminal.

What You Need to Know

As road widening activities progress along the west side of Hurontario Street in Mississauga South, crews will be installing permanent concrete curbs and gutters from north of Inglewood Drive to Indian Valley Trail.

These works are scheduled to take place from July 5 to 31, 2024. To safely accommodate these works, driveways for properties within this stretch will be intermittently and partially impacted between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday for up to four hours. To accommodate motorists needing to enter and exit driveways impacted during working hours, steel plates will be used to provide immediate access to the property once the curb machine passes through.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, and other construction equipment related to this work.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work is scheduled to start on July 5, 2024, and finish by July 31, 2024.
- Work involving driveway closures will generally occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday. There will be no weekend work for these activities.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians & cyclists as detours will be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- MiWay will continue to operate with regular service.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.
- Visit www.miway.ca/updates for updates on your bus route.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Crews will not require access to private property. All works will take place within the public right of way.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
- Driveways are expected to be intermittently impacted between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for a total of 4 hours.
