

NEW INTERSECTION: Opening of the Eaglewood Boulevard Bridge and the demolition of the Inglewood Drive Bridge

Thursday July 4, 2024

Demolition works are scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 5p.m. July 5, 2024, to July 29, 2024.



What work is taking place?

The Hazel McCallion Line is making great progress in Mississauga South and will connect the communities on the east and west sides of Hurontario Street at Eaglewood Boulevard with a new signalized intersection. With the new bridge structure over Mary Fix Creek complete, motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists will be able to cross Hurontario Street using Eaglewood Boulevard to get to and from Oriole Avenue.

Crews will be energizing the temporary traffic signals at Eaglewood Boulevard and Hurontario Street on Tuesday, June 25, 2024. Once the new intersection is opened, the traffic signals at Inglewood Drive will be removed, and the bridge structure will be demolished. This will allow crews to install a sanitary crossing underneath Mary Fix Creek and finish constructing the flood walls north of Eaglewood Boulevard.

Demolition of the bridge structure at Inglewood Drive will take place after the new intersection at Eaglewood Boulevard is opened to road users. Demolition works are scheduled to take place from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. from July 5, 2024, to July 29, 2024**. No night or weekend work is planned for this activity.

TIMING

- The new Eaglewood Boulevard intersection is scheduled to be open to the public on Thursday, July 4, 2024.
- Demolition of the Inglewood Drive bridge structure is scheduled to occur between the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. from Friday, July 5 to Monday, July 29, 2024. No night or weekend work is planned for this activity.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances-

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Temporary lane reductions will be required on Hurontario Street.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay will continue to operate with regular service.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please ensure any personal belongings, such as signs, benches and underground sprinklers on city owned land have been relocated prior to the beginning of construction.
- For details on your property boundaries, please refer to your land survey, or consult an Ontario Land Surveyor.
